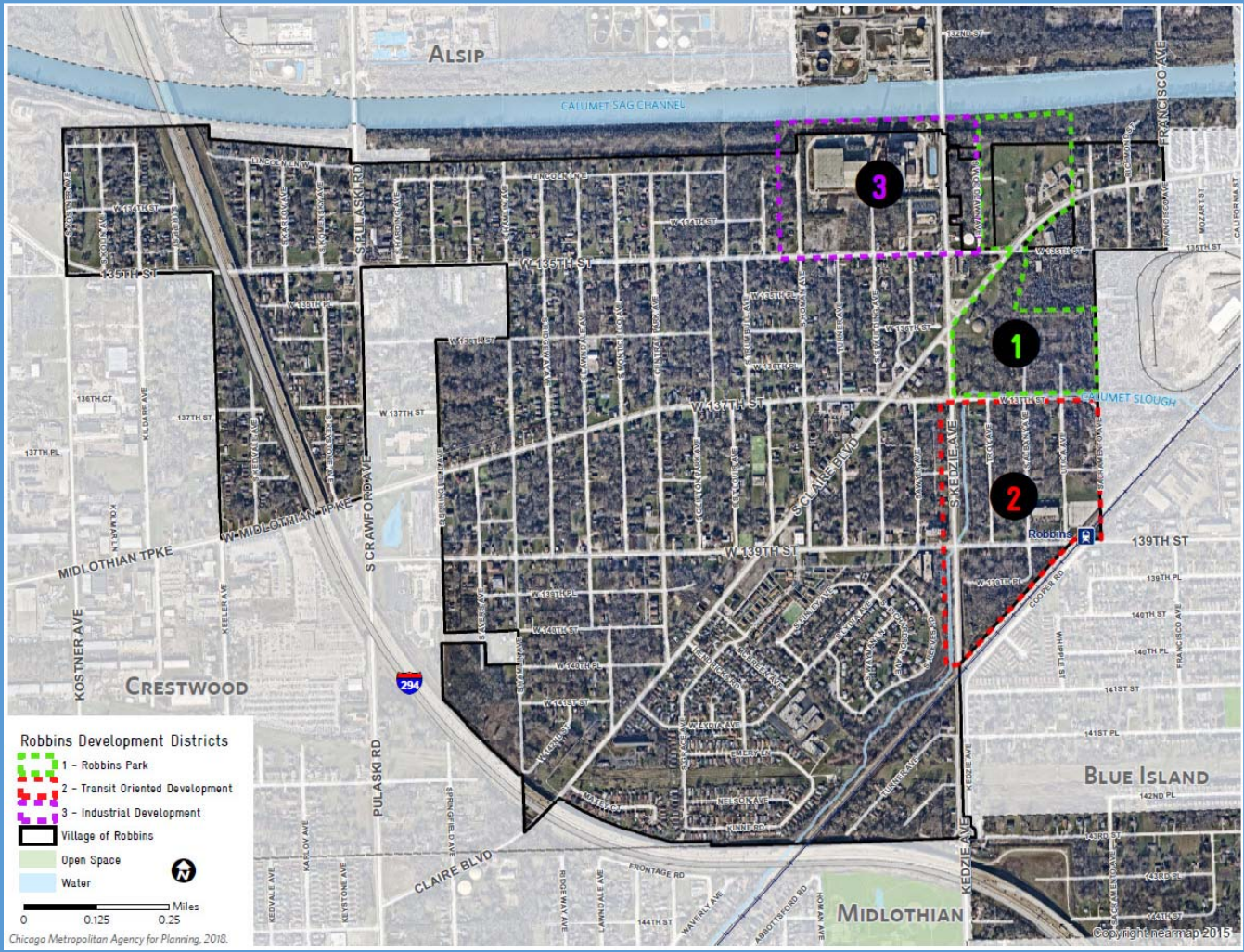

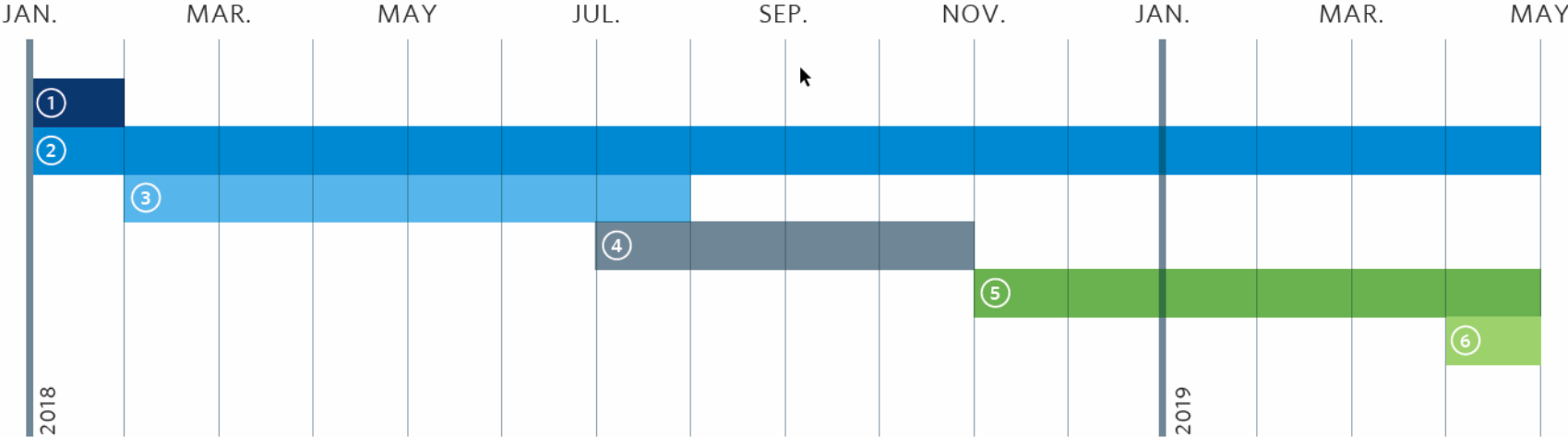

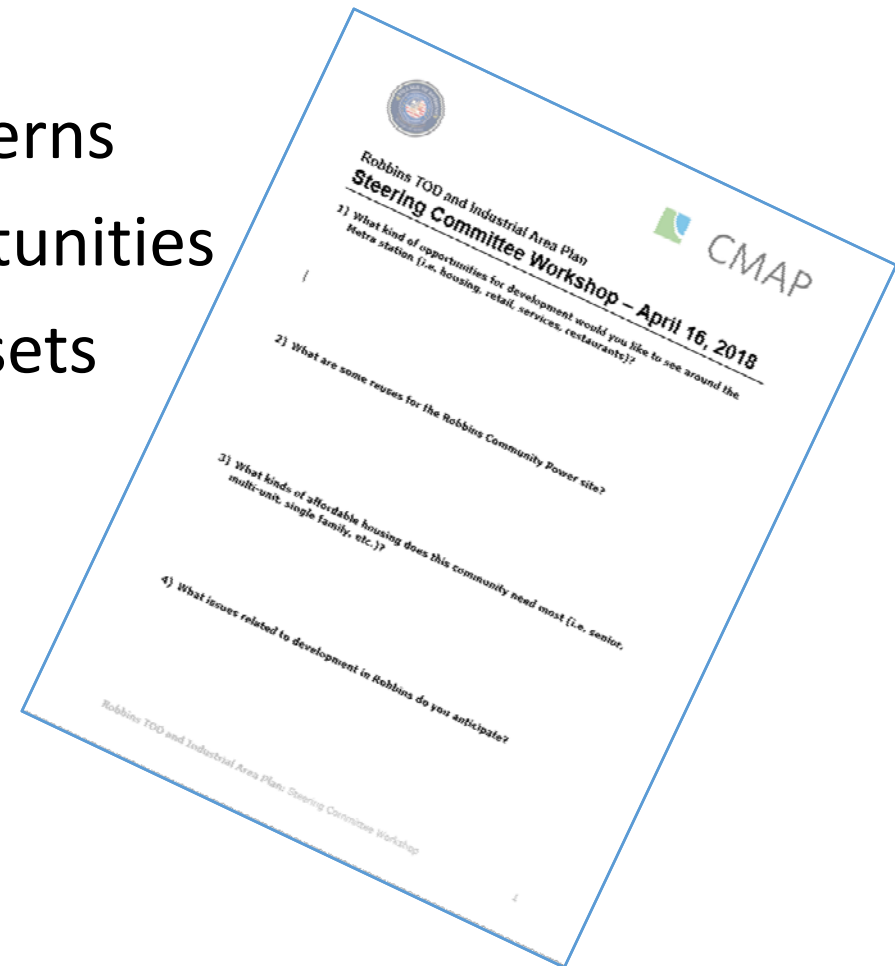

Role of Steering Committee

- Monitors the quality of the project as it develops
- Provides advice (and sometimes makes decisions) about changes to the project as it progresses.
- Provides support, guidance and oversight of progress.
- Members do not usually work on the project themselves.
- Members help identify key persons for informational interviews

Steering Committee Exercise

- Identify issues and concerns
- Identify potential opportunities
- Highlight community assets

- Develop Village-wide survey
- Create Existing Conditions Report
