4.1 Kane County DOT - Orchard Road/Randall Road to Rochester Drive (TIP ID 09-09-0011)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$81,100 total (\$64,880 federal). Staff recommends approval.

4.2 Kane County DOT – Randall Road at Bolcum Road/Ridgewood Drive (TIP ID 09-06-0002)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$515,909 total (\$412,727 federal). Staff recommends approval.

4.3 Kane County DOT - Randall Road/Dean Street to Main Street (TIP ID 09-09-0012)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$125,125 total (\$100,100 federal). Staff recommends approval.

4.4 Kane County DOT – Dunham Road/Kirk Road from Stearns Road to IL 56/Butterfield Road (TIP ID 09-10-0005)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$202,100 total (\$161,680 federal). Staff recommends approval.

1.0 Call to Order and Introductions

Ross Patronsky, Committee Chair called the meeting to order at 2:05 p.m. Members and attendees introduced themselves.

2.0 Agenda Changes and Announcements

There were no agenda changes or announcements.

3.0 Approval of June 2, 2011 Minutes

On a motion by Mayor Keller and a second by Mr. Pitstick, the draft minutes for the June 2, 2011 meeting were approved as presented.

4.0 **Project Changes**

4.1 McHenry County DOT – Walkup Rd/Crystal Lake Rd from Bull Valley to IL 176 (TIP ID 11-03-0019) On a motion by Mr. Buehler and a second by Ms. Stitt, the Committee approved a cost increase of \$13,459,000 total (\$3,351,054 federal).

4.2 Illinois Environmental Protection Agency – Chicago Area Diesel Retrofit Program (TIP ID 13-09-0003)

On a motion by Mayor Keller and a second by Mr. Rogers, the Committee approved a scope change and \$500,000 cost increase to increase the number of school districts receiving retrofits.

4.3 Lincolnwood – Lincolnwood Union Pacific (UP) Rail Line/Weber Spur Bike/Multiuse Trail (TIP ID 02-10-0001)

Mr. Pietrowiak said that Lincolnwood requested a transfer of funds from Phase-2 engineering into Phase-1 engineering. This was undertaken as an administrative modification.

4.4 Lincolnwood - Lincolnwood Commonwealth Edison (Com Ed) Utility ROW / Skokie Valley Bike/Multiuse Trail (TIP ID 02-10-0002)

Mr. Pietrowiak said that Lincolnwood requested a transfer of funds from Phase-2 engineering into Phase-1 engineering. This was undertaken as an administrative modification.

4.5 Kane County DOT – Huntley Rd at Galligan Rd (TIP ID 09-09-0010)

Mr. Pietrowiak said Kane County requested a transfer of funds from right of way acquisition to Phase-2 engineering and Construction. This was undertaken as an administrative modification.

5.0 Active Program Management

5.1 May 2011 May Status Updates

Ms. Ostdick reported that the May status updates have been collected for 178 project phases. 84% were reported correctly, 13% were reported, but incorrectly (i.e. in with information for another phase), 1% did not submit. She pointed out that 36% of project phases required to be obligated by September 30th were obligated in May. She said that she anticipates that some will not make the September deadline, but 63% of 2011 project phases have already had a one-time move, so they may be considered for removal from the program if a move is requested during the October 2011 and the reason for delay is within the sponsor's control. She reported that the most common reason cited for delay was coordination with IDOT and other agencies.

She reported that staff recommends one project be removed from the program at this time, Oak Forest's 158th St and 155th St sidewalk project between Laramie Ave and Cicero Ave-TIP ID 07-10-0002. The sponsor has been contacted and agrees that they cannot pursue it at this time. On a motion by Ms. Stitt and a second by Mr. Buehler, the Committee approved the request.

5.2 Contingency Project Forum

Ms. Ostdick stated that everyone agrees accomplishing the regularly programmed projects is the first priority. She informed the Committee that a summary of the meeting and list of projects was included in the packet. Ms. Stitt responded that, while agreeing with Ms. Ostdick's statement on accomplishing the regularly programmed projects as the first priority, a strong second priority is to not lose any federal funding. The committee members discussed various perspectives and settled on releasing the contingency list for public comment with the proposed program, just in case it should be used. Mr. Blankenhorn addressed the Committee saying that November 2011 is too soon to put this kind of an emergency strategy into action, and pointed out that in October a whole 5-year program will be adopted from which ready projects can be drawn over the next 15 months. He commented that he has no problem with doing contingency planning at this time, even presenting a list of potential projects to the public, if warranted. He said he would like to see more focus put on why the current projects are not being implemented in a more timely fashion.

Mr. Donovan reminded the Committee that if past history is used as the indicator it is unlikely that the region will obligate \$190 million by September of 2013. Mr. Privett commented that if we were to take a list of potential contingency projects out for public review more time needs to be provided for adding projects as CDOT and RTA are on record saying that they have others to submit. He also suggested calling the list the C List as it would fill in projects after those on the A List and B List are accommodated. Mr. Rogers pointed out that a C List project could easily jump over a B List project if its timing is a match to what is needed.

Mr. Pitstick commented that the region is still at risk of rescission. Ms. Ostdick stated that even if we implement contingency projects, the CMAQ program will be at risk of rescission until the entire unobligated balance is spent. Mr. Tomzik asked if the C List projects would be ranked and Mr. Patronsky responded that, in his perspective, staff would do an air quality cost/ benefit analysis of each, but projects would not be ranked against each other in the traditional way.

Mr. Connelly commented that we need to proceed in a transparent fashion; if we implement this contingency strategy, the reasons should be laid out including an explanation of how hard the region has tried to get the regularly programmed projects done first. Ms. Ostdick pointed out that, if the committee believes implementing the currently programmed projects is the highest priority and the projects listed as being ready in summer and fall of 2013 are not currently fully funded, then adding the un-funded projects to the contingency list will not guarantee funding. Therefore the chances of the sponsors accomplishing the projects without having construction funding are small. However, there are numerous projects that are ready to go immediately. She suggested completing another contingency forum near the end of FFY 2013 to find the projects that will be ready for immediate implementation near the end of FFY 2013. Ms. Stitt agreed revisiting this nearer to implementation of a contingency strategy for about 15 months and the Committee concurred.

5.3 Unobligated Balance by Sponsor

Ms. Ostdick explained the exhibit summarizing analysis of the \$300 million unobligated balance by sponsor to the Committee. Committee members asked that CMAP distribute the list of individual projects that are not fully obligated. Ms. Ostdick agreed and asked sponsoring agencies to review their lists and to contact her if any inaccuracies are identified.

6.0 Program Focus Groups

A representative of each of the four program focus groups presented a short summary of their group's deliberations and results. Later, project sponsors were given a chance to speak about their projects.

For the Regional Transportation Operations Coalition (RTOC), Mr. Steve Travia of IDOT drew the Committee's attention to the June 30th memo from the focus group and gave highlights. He said that RTOC looked at projects which had operational impacts on higher level routes such as highways, SRA routes and other major arterials. RTOC identified a package of projects totaling \$177.2 million in CMAQ requests that breaks out into three categories: system modernization and intelligent transportation systems (ITS); corridor recommendations (i.e. packages of projects that if implemented together would provide discernable benefits to particular roadways); and special or unique projects serving important operational concerns. A fourth operations program was also submitted consisting of strategies and projects which the RTOC believes should be undertaken by the region, and supported by CMAQ or other funding, but which were not yet put forward as project applications.

Mr. Mike Rogers of the Illinois EPA spoke for the Direct Emissions Reduction Focus Group, saying that CDOT, CTA, Metra, Pace, private railroads, Chicago DOE, the Respiratory Health Assoc., the US EPA and the IL EPA participated. He drew the Committee's attention to the June 30th memo from the focus group and gave highlights: that their focus was reducing exhaust and idling, repowering /replacing engines, new fueling technologies and alternative fuels. The GO TO 2040 action areas most involved are modernize the region's transit system and conservation of energy. The focus group saw their main goal as reducing VOC, NOx and particulate matter emissions and secondarily, to reduce petroleum consumption and greenhouse gas emissions. They screened projects by proximity to sensitive populations (children and seniors) and to areas of high levels of reported asthma cases; whether the project demonstrates innovative/state of the art technology and if the project improves the condition of the region's fleets. Several plans were considered supportive of GO TO 2040: the IEPA's State Implementation Plan and related programs, the Chicago Climate Action Plan, municipal sustainability plans, private sector sustainability plans and Pace's Strategic Plan. Eighteen projects were reviewed and 9 were recommended for CMAQ inclusion as a package. Ms. Hamilton noted that the IEPA's umbrella project making sub grants to sponsors has a 50/50 matching requirement which is down from the 65/35 ratio CMAQ had done previously. Mr. Rogers noted that this is an ongoing program through IEPA which has been at a 50% match.

Mr. Tom Rickert spoke for the Bicycle and Pedestrian Task Force and stated that the Task Force was proposing a package of projects intended to achieve mode shift (i.e. a shift from single-occupant private vehicles (SOV) to transit and/or non-motorized modes). The projects in the package feature innovation and best practices; improving access to transit and providing seamless coordination and connection between modes; addressing substantial barriers to walking and cycling (including gaps in the cycling network); and supporting *complete streets* concepts, which will create modernized, multi-modal roadways. Mr. Rickert reviewed the Task Force's work examining and analyzing of a wide range information and data for each project proposal in regards to: the purpose of each project; the scale or functional class of affected infrastructure (i.e. were facilities on or over arterials and collectors, as opposed to local streets); and consistency with GO TO 2040 and existing supportive (local and sub-regional) plans. The Task Force selected projects that: had good proximity/access to transit; supported *complete streets* concepts by providing non-motorized accommodation to motorized transportation projects; built out the network in the Regional Greenways and Trails Plan (especially those projects that would close significant gaps in this network); and/or overcame barriers to walking and biking, especially pedestrian-focused projects that were either innovative and/or would significantly improve access to transit. The Task Force has provided two lists or matrices – those projects that are recommended (with the primary package's suggested funding totaling \$80 million), and which is sub-divided into listing in several tiers, and those projects that are not recommended for funding because they either do not have a discernable planning basis or serve only purely local needs.

Mr. Mark Pitstick spoke for the Transit Focus Group which was made up of RTA, CTA, Metra, Pace, CNT and CDOT staff and said that the group reviewed 39 projects and produced two lists: the recommended list and the not included in recommended list. The criteria reviewed in support of this effort included three areas: *advancement of GO TO 2040 action areas*, which was an analysis of how likely a project was to advance each action area specifically identified in the GO TO 2040 focused program approach adopted by the MPO Policy Committee; *Plan Basis* which was an analysis of the project's relationship to specific GO TO 2040 major capital projects or other adopted plans and *Project Readiness* which was an evaluation of how ready the sponsor is to implement the project. The six projects being forwarded for CMAQ program particularly address the following action areas: *focus investment on modernization, adopt best practices in new technologies, establish seamless coordination between modes* and *include transit components as part of highway major capital projects*.

Ross thanks the Focus Groups for all their good work and indicated that the projects will be discussed further at the next meeting.

7.0 FY 2012-2016 CMAQ Program

7.1 Program Mark

Mr. Ferguson discussed the exhibit on CMAQ apportionments and the development of draft programming marks for FFY 2012 through 2016. He pointed out that there are numerous uncertainties about the future of the CMAQ program and the marks are not up for approval at this meeting. Staff considered the \$90 million annual apportionment level to be conservative in the context of previous apportionments. He mentioned that a rescission was announced at the end of June, yet how the CMAQ program will be affected has not been determined. Ms. Stitt stated that the effect on the CMAQ program will be available on Friday July 8th. The staff recommendation will be refined with Committee member input and presented for the Committee's consideration on July 21st.

7.2 Project Rankings

Mr. Ferguson discussed the preliminary project rankings exhibit which summarizes the findings for the 369 proposed projects in terms of VOC, NOx and particulate matter eliminated as well as VMT and trips eliminated. He said that the final rankings will be available before the next meeting.

Mr. Snyder asked how the focus groups' recommendations would be folded into the project selection thinking. He also told the Committee that most of the highway agencies are having the experience of project bids coming in well below the engineers' estimates. He said that this phenomenon further erodes the region's ability to spend down the unobligated balance. He suggested that it may not be wise to put off the consideration of contingency projects until next year. Ms. Ostdick answered his questions and the Committee reiterated their comfort in focusing on getting the regularly programmed projects accomplished for now.

Mr. Jason Osborn of McHenry County addressed the Committee to explain why he feels that the Randall Road pedestrian crossing in Algonquin ranked poorly despite very strong benefits. He believes that, while the project is near a high school and areas of high concentration of restaurants and medical facilities, there is little ability to cross Randall road for 3 miles and that the VOC analysis is affected by the context. Mr. Murtha indicated that the Bike/Ped Task Force placed this project in their "neutral" category.

Mr. Pitstick Spoke about the *Chicago Commute Options* project for comprehensive transportation demand management which is similar to Pace's rideshare marketing in its ability to get single occupant vehicles off the road. Mr. Gerry Tumbali of the RTA explained the five key tasks in the proposal.

Mr. Buehler noted that if the recommendations of the four focus groups were to be adopted that would utilize \$446 million, just about all the CMAQ funding. Options on how to proceed were discussed and it was suggested that besides the air quality rankings and focus group recommendations, project readiness and implementer interest will be considered. Ms. Sharon Feigon of CNT asked the Committee to "push the envelope" in order to give strong consideration to the worthy demonstration projects.

8.0 Other Business

Ms. Berry reminded the Committee of the concerns which Mayor Mulder brought up at the last meeting about how slow the process to obtain right of way can be. Ms. Berry informed the group that Mike Walczak, the planning liaison for the Northwest Council is working with the mayor to find a solution.

9.0 Public Comment

There were no public comments.

10.0 Next Meeting

The next meeting is scheduled for July 21, 2011 at 2:00 p.m.

Nine projects have been submitted for changes. The net change in the federal CMAQ amount programmed is \$6,697,910 total (\$5,358,327 federal). The sponsors' requests are attached.

For Committee Consideration:

Kane County – Orchard Road from Randall Road to Rochester Drive (TIP ID 09-09-0011) The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$81,100 total (\$64,880 federal) for a total project cost of \$756,600 (\$605,280 federal). The cost increase being requested is to bring the federal share of the construction cost to the maximum allowable 80%. This project was let for construction on March 11, 2011, if approved the construction funding agreement will be amended. A re-ranking was completed and the project dropped from 1st to 2nd.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Consider approval of the cost increase of \$81,100 total (\$64,880 CMAQ federal) for a total project cost of \$756,600 (\$603,280 federal) for Kane County – Orchard Road from Randall Road to Rochester Drive (TIP ID 09-09-0011).

Kane County – Randall Road at Bolcum Road/Ridgewood Drive (TIP ID 09-06-0002)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$515,909 total (\$412,727 federal) for a total project cost of \$1,031,309 (\$825,047 federal). The cost increase being requested is to bring the federal share of the construction cost to the maximum allowable 80%. This project was let for construction on March 11, 2011, if approved the construction funding agreement will be amended. Expenditures associated with this project total \$514,613 (\$411,690 CMAQ federal). A re-ranking was completed and the project dropped from 2nd to 5th.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Consider approval of the cost increase of \$515,909 total (\$412,727 federal) for a total project cost of \$1,031,309 (\$825,047 federal) for Randall Road at Bolcum Road/Ridgewood Drive (TIP ID 09-06-0002).

Kane County – Randall Road from Dean Street to Main Street (TIP ID 09-09-0012)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$125,125 total (\$100,100 federal) for a total project cost of \$1,127,000 (\$901,600 federal). The cost increase being requested is to bring the federal share of the construction cost to the maximum allowable 80%. This project was let for construction on January 21, 2011, if approved the construction funding agreement will be amended. Expenditures associated with this project total \$1,001,358 (\$801,087 federal). A reranking was completed and the project dropped from 3rd to 5th.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Consider approval of the cost increase of \$125,125 total (\$100,100 federal) for a total project cost of \$1,127,000 (\$901,600 federal) for Randall Road from Dean Street to Main Street (TIP ID 09-09-0012).

Kane County – Dunham Road/Kirk Road from Stearns Road to IL 56/Butterfield Road (TIP ID 09-10-0005)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$202,100 total (\$161,680 federal) for a total project cost of \$2,373,100 (\$1,898,480 federal). The cost increase being requested is to add funding for Construction Engineering. This project is expected to be let in FY 2011. Expenditures associated with this project total \$150,000 (\$120,000 federal). A re-ranking was completed and the rank remains the same.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Consider approval of the cost increase of \$202,100 total (\$161,680 federal) for a total project cost of \$2,373,100 (\$1,898,480 federal) for Dunham Road/Kirk Road from Stearns Road to IL 56/Butterfield Road (TIP ID 09-10-0005).

Kane County - Arterial Operations Center (TIP ID 09-11-0013)

The sponsor is requesting an administrative modification to transfer \$140,473 (\$112,388 federal) from project 09-09-0013 (IL 64 from Randall Road to Burlington Road Signal Interconnect), that was let in June 2011, and a cost increase of \$230,103 total (\$184,082 federal) for a total project cost of \$1,069,000 (\$855,200 federal). The cost increase being requested is for increased construction costs. The project was originally programmed as part of project 09-09-0013, and was separated earlier this year to accommodate a request from IDOT to let the Signal Interconnect project separate from the Arterial Operations Center. The project is expected to be let on August 5, 2011. Expenditures associated with this project total \$150,000 (\$120,000 federal). A re-ranking was completed and the project dropped from 16th to 17th, falling below one unfunded project from the FY 2009 CMAQ Program.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Consider the transfer of remaining funds from 09-09-0013 and the cost increase of \$230,130 total (\$184,082 federal) for a total project cost \$1,069,000 (\$855,200 federal) for the Kane County Arterial Operations Center (TIP ID 09-11-0013).

Kane County - Randall Road at US 20/Foothill Road (TIP ID 09-06-0003)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$983,573 total (\$786,858 federal) for a total project cost of \$2,402,573 (\$1,922,058 federal). The cost increase being requested is for increased construction costs and to add funding for Construction Engineering. The project is expected to be let in FY 2011. Expenditures associated with this project total \$226,335 (\$181,068 federal). A re-ranking was completed and the project dropped from 2nd to 5th.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Consider approval of the cost increase of \$983,573 total (\$786,858 federal) for a total project cost of \$2,402,573 (\$1,922,058 federal) for Randall Road at US 20/Foothill Road (TIP ID 09-06-0003).

DuPage County DOT – Thorndale Ave from I-290 Entrance Ramp to Park Blvd (TIP ID 08-07-0003)

The sponsor is requesting to transfer \$330,000 (\$264,000 federal) from Phase 2 Engineering to Construction and a cost increase of \$4,560,000 total (\$3,648,000 federal) for a total project cost of \$5,140,000 (\$4,112,000 federal). The cost increase being requested is to replace \$3.2 million in STP funds programmed by the DuPage Council and add construction engineering funds which were not included by the DuPage Council. The project is expected to be let on March 9, 2012. Expenditures associated with this project total \$153,210 (\$122,568 federal) for Phase 1 Engineering. Phase 2 Engineering has been funded with local funds. A re-ranking was completed and the rank remained the same.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Consider approval of the transfer of \$330,000 (\$264,000 federal) from Phase 2 Engineering to Construction and the cost increase of \$4,560,000 total (\$3,648,000 federal) for a total project cost of \$5,140,000 (\$4,112,000 federal) Thorndale Ave from I-290 Entrance Ramp to Park Blvd.

CTA – Ethanol Fuel Cell Bus Program (TIP ID 16-95-0039) and Western Avenue Bus stops (TIP ID 16-00-001)

The sponsor is requesting a transfer of \$100,000 (\$80,000 federal) funds to from Ethanol Fuel Cell Bus Program (TIP ID 16-95-0039) to CTA- Western Ave Express Bus Stops (TIP ID 16-00-001). The Western Ave Express Bus Stops program relocates bus stops to the far side of the intersection, improving both transit operations and reducing disruption to the other roadway users. The Bus Stops project was obligated in April 2000 at \$333,000 (\$266,400 federal). The additional funds are expected to expand the Western Ave Bus Stops program by approximately 10 stops so the project would maintain its original cost/benefit ranking. While the Committee

approved the transfer of these \$80,000 CMAQ dollars from the Ethanol Fuel Cell Bus Program to a different project in September of 2003, the project that the funds were to be added to encountered problems and the CTA decided not to make the transfer. Both projects are in FTA grant IL 90-x377, so the mechanics of the transfer will be straightforward.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Approve the transfer of \$100,000 (\$80,000 federal) funds to from Ethanol Fuel Cell Bus Program (TIP ID 16-95-0039) to CTA- Western Ave Express Bus Stops (TIP ID 16-00-001).

CTA – Transfer of \$1,942,500 (\$1,554,000 federal) from four existing CTA CMAQ projects for use on the CTA's TIGGER funded All Electric, Battery Powered Demonstration Bus Project (TIP ID 16-96-0061).

The sponsor is requesting to transfer of \$1,942,500 (\$1,554,000 federal) CMAQ funding from four 2009 projects identified by the CTA as on hold for lack of local match in the last transit quarterly update. The projects are:

- #X49 Western Ave. Express Bus Weekend Service (TIP ID 16-09-0005) for \$881,250 (\$705,000 federal)
- #125 Water Tower Express Midday and Weekend Service (TIP ID 16-09-0002) for \$653,750 (\$523,000 federal)
- #152 Addison Weekend and Evening Service (TIP ID 16-09-0004) for \$178,750 (\$143,000 federal), and
- New Bus Service between Navy Pier and Museum Campus (TIP ID 16-09-0001) for \$228,750 (\$183,000 federal).

The funds will be added to the CTA's TIGGER-funded all electric, battery powered demonstration bus project (TIP ID 16-96-0061) which will evaluate emerging clean propulsion technology. The electric buses have zero tail pipe emissions. This project is considered a demonstration project for CMAQ program purposes, hence does not require an up-front benefits analysis. The FTA has indicated that if the funds transfer is approved, CTA can amend the scope of their current grant IL 95-x014 to accommodate work on the all-electric bus demonstration project. The local match is available through transportation development credits.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Approve the transfer of \$1,942,500 (\$1,554,000 federal) from four existing CTA CMAQ projects for use on the CTA's TIGGER funded all electric, battery powered demonstration bus project (TIP ID 16-96-0061).

Villa Park - Villa Park - Roosevelt Road Sidewalk from Ardmore to Michigan (TIP ID 08-02-0008)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$75,635 total (\$60,508 federal) for a total project cost of \$1,394,635 total (\$1,115,708 federal). The cost increase is due to the Clean Construction and

Demolition Debris regulations. The project is on the November 2011 letting. A re-ranking was completed and the rank remained the same. Staff recommends approval.

Administrative Modifications:

DuPage County DOT – Geneva Rd from President St to Swift Rd (TIP ID 08-10-0004)

The sponsor is requesting to extend the project from President St. to Schmale Rd. Total project cost would remain unchanged at \$1,155,000 (\$924,000 federal). Staff undertook this action as an administrative change.

Realizing the CMAQ Project Selection Committee's desire to expend the unobligated fund balance and achieve regional air quality and congestion relief benefits, Kane County is requesting the Committee's consideration of additional CMAQ funding for the following projects. The identified project phases have been subject to cost increases and the original CMAQ allocation is now less than 80% of the project cost. Therefore, Kane County is requesting CMAQ funding increases to fully fund 80% of eligible project costs. The funding request totals \$1,710,327 and is itemized per project as follows:

Kane County is requesting budget revisions to:

CMAQ Project # 09-09-0013 IL 64/Randall Road to Burlington Road Signal interconnect project and CMAQ Project # 09-11-0013 IL 64/Randall Road to Burlington Road Arterial Operations Center (AOC) project.

The actual construction cost for the Signal Interconnect (SI) project is \$597,353 rather than the latest estimated cost of \$750,000. Therefore, the CMAQ funding for this project component must be reduced to 80% of the actual project cost (from \$590,000 to \$477,882) leaving a balance of \$112,118.

Kane County is requesting the transfer of this remaining funding (\$112,118) to the construction phase of the AOC project (09-11-0013). Although this request appears to involve the transfer of CMAQ funds between 2 separate projects, these projects initially comprised 1 CMAQ project.

As the attached letter indicates, the original CMAQ application included both the signal interconnect and AOC project components. In early 2011, IDOT requested that the project be separated into 2 distinct projects, creating 2 separate TIP numbers. CMAP approved the request as proposed.

Due to the relationship of these project components, Kane County requests an administrative modification for the reallocation of \$112,118 to the AOC project as described below:

SI Construction: Reduce the construction cost to \$597,353 and the respective CMAQ allocation from \$590,000 to \$477,882.

AOC Construction: Increase the cost estimate to \$1,069,000 including E3 (\$178,000) and increase the CMAQ allocation from \$559,000 to \$671,118.

Holly- DuPage County DOT would like to request that E2 CMAQ funding (\$264k) be moved to Construction. E2 will use non-federal funding.

Total construction (\$4,672,700) and construction engineering (\$467,300) cost is estimated to be \$5,140,000. We request an increase in CMAQ construction funds from \$464k (\$264k E2 + \$200K Construction) to \$4,112,000 (80% of total construction/E3 cost). STP funding secured for this project (3,212,000) will be returned to DMMC for re-programming.

Please include this request on the next PSC agenda for consideration. This project is currently targeted for a March, 2012 IDOT letting.

Also note that while DuPage County is the lead for E1 and E2, IDOT will be the lead for Construction/E3. Please advise if we need to do anything more to ensure that the CMAQ funds carry over to IDOT.

The Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) hereby requests the transfer of federal funds in the amount of \$80,000 from the Develop Ethanol Fuel Cell Program to the Improve Western Avenue Express Bus Stops project. Both of these projects are in FTA grant IL-90-X377.

The prior request and approval by CMAP to move these funds to Express Bus Service for #79 79th Street, #22 Clark Street, and #9 Ashland was not exercised. In addition, express bus service was eliminated February 2010.

CMAP gave approval for the scope of the Western Avenue Express Bus Stop project to include relocation of bus shelters on the Western Avenue Corridor. Moving bus stops and shelters to the farside (after the intersection) is of prime importance for these reasons. Farside stops allow the buses to get through the traffic light, and then start moving again as soon as loading/unloading is done. This helps keep the buses closer to schedule, and the more far side stops there are, the more time that can be saved. A farside stop eliminates the blocking of right-turning traffic behind a stopped bus nearside, and also eliminates the dangerous practice of motorists making a right turn in front of a stopped bus. This transfer of additional funds to the Western Avenue Bus Stop project will provide for approximately 10 additional bus stops to be relocated.

Dear Mr. Patronsky,

The Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) was the recipient of a Transit Investment in Greenhouse Gas and Energy Reduction (TIGGER) grant from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) in the amount of \$2,210,490 in FY 2010. The funds will be used to purchase up to two all-electrical, battery-powered demonstration buses and one or more charging stations for the purpose of evaluating emerging clean propulsion technology. The all-electric bus has zero tail pipe emissions. The purpose of this project is to evaluate performance of a vehicle with an all-electric propulsion system and assess its viability in our service conditions. Specifically, this project was selected by FTA to test this new technology in a cold climate. The CTA will report performance results to FTA. The elimination of local emissions such as nitrogen oxides and particulate matter and the mitigation of greenhouse gases is paramount to the goal of this project.

CTA has been investigating the cost of purchasing these two buses and terminal and wayside chargers. There is the possibility that due to cost of the bus (Foothill Transit purchased a single electric bus for \$1.2m) CTA would only be able to purchase one electric bus and charger with existing TIGGER funding.


Therefore, the CTA is hereby requesting the transfer of Federal funds in the amount of \$1,554,000 from the following 2009 CMAQ funded projects (listed below) to the FTA > TIGGER funded all-electric bus project. Due to financial constraints, CTA is unable to provide for the local match for these 2009 projects. The electric bus project offers a unique opportunity for CMAP to collaborate with CTA in exploring next generation propulsion technology with a regional air quality benefit.

In addition, the proposed all-electric buses could potentially supplement service along CDOT/CTA's planned East-West Transit Corridor between Union Station and Navy Pier. which was recently selected for an award of \$24 million from FTA's Urban Circulator Systems grant program. Proposed elements of the East-West Transit Corridor include the following:

- Enhanced downtown Circulator bus service in the corridor to connect transit terminals and stations to the fast growing Streeterville area and Navy Pier
- A new Transportation Center at Union Station to be located at Canal Street and Jackson Boulevard that will serve CTA buses
- Designated bus priority lanes on two miles of streets, including Madison Street/Washington Boulevard and Canal/Clinton Streets

In addition to a quick-charge unit to be installed at a selected garage, to which these vehicles will be assigned, additional quick-charge units could be installed at one or more endpoints of the East-West Transit Corridor. This corridor serves as a significant tourist population and is ideally suited for demonstrating our innovative transit technology to a global population.



CTA also requests a grant extension of one year for the 2009 funded Split Route Pullman #111th/#115th into Separate Routes (16-09-0003) project. Currently, CTA does not have matching local share funds, however a plan is being formulated to identify local match for this project in the future.

This is to update CMAP on the status of the referenced project and request an additional allocation of CMAQ funds, for reasons outlined below. Once CMAP has reviewed this request, I'd like to work with you to provide the attached Project Program Initiation form (D1 P10004) and Local Agency Amendment #3 for Federal Participation BLR 05311 to Temi Latinwo for IDOT project funding approval of the project's construction and construction engineering costs.

CURRENT STATUS: The current status of the project is that it is still pending the sign-off on two parcels of ROW. One of the parcels is in the process of a friendly condemnation. The other is awaiting review and approval of the acquisition documents by the property owner's attorney. Although we remain hopeful of a September 23rd letting, a November 18th letting is more probable. We anticipate that all ROW will be acquired within the prior overall approved \$88,300 project ROW funding, of which \$70,640 represented the federal share.

REASON FOR REQUEST OF ADDITIONAL CMAQ FUNDS: As a result of the significant amount of soils classified as nonspecial waste on the project, the disposal cost of the excavated soils from the project has increased dramatically, causing the estimated construction cost to exceed the CMAQ allocation for the project. The specific costs to provide construction engineering services are now known as opposed to the rough percentage basis that was used to estimate those costs when the latest CMAQ funding request was made and approved. The Estimate of Cost for the Bid Documents is attached.

ADDITIONAL CMAQ FUNDS REQUESTED: The prior CMAQ approved funding level was set for an overall project cost of \$877,000 of which \$701,600 represented the federal share. The new overall project cost reflecting the increases in construction cost and construction engineering cost is \$963,443. Since \$10,808 is considered as non-participating, the remaining 80% federal share becomes \$762,108. <u>We request that CMAP allocate an additional \$60,508 of CMAQ</u> federal funds to the project.
