The apportionment estimate for FFY 2013 is \$100 million and the estimate for subsequent years is \$101 million. The current unobligated balance is approximately \$148 million. 1.0 Call to Order

Committee Chair Ross Patronsky called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

2.0 Agenda Changes and Announcements

Chairman Patronsky requested that CMAP staff present a short briefing on the new Transportation Reauthorization, MAP-21, and how it may affect the CMAQ program prior to considering the agenda. He also requested that item 6.0 be considered at 2:30 p.m. to accommodate Jeff South of IDOT. The Committee agreed to the requested agenda changes.

Ms. Berry distributed copies of MAP-21 language pertaining to the CMAQ program, and reported that in areas that are in non-attainment for fine particular matter, including the CMAP region, 25 % of the state's CMAQ apportionment must be spent on projects that reduce fine particulate matter. She noted that since our region's FFY 2013-16 funding is already programmed, this new requirement may not have an immediate impact on our program. Mr. Urbaszewski noted that the MAP-21 language on projects that reduce fine particulate matter is open to interpretation at this point. Mr. Donovan stated that FHWA staff was still exploring that issue, but it appears the 100% federal CMAQ provision will not be available after September 30, 2012.

3.0 Approval of Minutes – May 24, 2012

On a motion by Mr. Keller and a second by Mr. Privett, the minutes of the May 24, 2012 meeting were approved as presented.

4.0 Project Changes

4.1 Des Plaines – Central Rd from Wolf Rd to East River Rd (TIP ID 03-08-0002)

The sponsor requested a cost increase of \$27,000 for a total project cost of \$592,000 (\$473,600 federal) and requested a 100% federal share. On a motion by Mr. Privett and a second by Mr. Carmitchel, the cost increase was approved and if available at the time of construction, a 100% federal share, up to a total of \$592,000, was approved.

4.2 Des Plaines – Pedestrian Refuge Medians (TIP ID 03-12-0011)

The City of Des Plaines requested a scope change which will reduce the cost of the CMAQ funded project by \$91,810 (\$73,414 federal) for a new project cost of \$89,190 (\$71,352 federal). The sponsor also requested a 100% federal share, but withdrew the request. On a motion by Mr. Snyder and a second by Mr. Pitstick, the scope change was approved.

4.3 Forest Preserve District of Cook County – Thorn Creek Bicycle Trail Completion (TIP ID 07-06-0058)

The sponsor requested a cost increase of \$1,382,133 (\$1,105,707 federal); the project is subject to deferral at the end of FFY 2012 and has not demonstrated readiness for a letting. On a motion by Mr. Privett and a second by Mr. Patronsky the request was tabled.

4.4 DuPage County DOT – **75th St at Cass Ave and Plainfield Rd (TIP ID 08-09-0016)** The County requested an increase in federal share for the project to 100%. On a motion by Mr. Pitstick and a second by Mr. Privett the increase in CMAQ federal share was approved if available.

4.5 DuPage County DOT – Fabyan Pkwy/Washington St at Roosevelt Rd (TIP ID 08-12-0006)

The County requested an increase in federal share for the project to 100%. On a motion by Mr. Carmichael and a second by Mayor Keller the increase in CMAQ federal share was approved if available.

- **4.6 DuPage County DuPage County Transit Service Marketing (TIP ID 08-05-0002)** DuPage County requested a sponsor changed to the RTA. Staff undertook this as an administrative modification.
- 4.7 IDOT 22nd St Sidewalk from IL 56/Butterfield Rd to IL 83/Kingery Highway (TIP ID 08-97-0010)

IDOT withdrew the project from the CMAQ program in the amount of \$340,516 federal. The project was completed using State funds. Staff undertook this as an administrative modification.

4.8 Pace – Emergency Ride Home Pilot Program (TIP ID 13-06-0002) Pace withdrew the project from the CMAQ program in the amount of \$276,000 federal. Staff undertook this as an administrative modification.

4.9 CDOT – Metropolitan Mayors Caucus Idling Reduction Program (13-10-0008)

The sponsor is withdrawing the project from the CMAQ program in the amount of \$140,600 federal. Staff undertook this as an administrative modification.

4.10 Cook County Highway Department – Lake Cook Rd at Buffalo Grove Rd (TIP ID 03-12-0017); Lake Cook Rd at Weiland Rd (TIP ID 03-12-0018); Lake Cook Rd at IL83/McHenry Rd (TIP ID 03-12-0019)

Cook County requested the merger of the three projects under TIP ID 03-11-0020. Staff undertook this as an administrative modification.

5.0 Program Monitoring

5.1 Programming Project Status Sheets

Mr. Ferguson noted that changes to this recurring report based on committee comments were made and reviewed with the committee how to interpret the report. The committee requested similar reporting for deferred projects in the future.

5.2 May Status Updates

Ms. Dobbs presented highlights of the status updates received in May for 2012 line items. She noted that 60% of the 216 line items have experienced delay, most during phase 1 or phase 2 engineering and that 55% of the delayed lines expect not to make an FFY 2012 obligation. She concluded that as the committee had noted in earlier discussions, it is anticipated that the new program management policies will substantially reduce such delays in the future.

5.3 Quarterly Transit Project Expenditure Status Report

Ms. Schaad presented highlights of the analysis of 1st Quarter 2012 transit expenditure updates. A brief discussion on the problems being encountered on several projects that appear to be stalled ensued.

6.0 FY 2013-2017 Obligation Goals

Mr. Ferguson said the estimated CMAQ apportionment for FFY 2013 is \$100 million. The obligation goal may be set by adding one fourth of the estimated unobligated balance at Sept 30 which would suggest an annual obligation goal in the \$132 million range. Mr. South suggested considering ramping up the proportion of the unobligated balance to be targeted each year, rather than splitting it evenly over the four years. That approach may give more time for the recently enacted policies to have their effect on program accomplishment. Alternatively, it was suggested that keeping the same annual goal may be easier for sponsors to understand and could motivate sponsors to keep their projects on schedule. It was agreed to continue the discussion at the August meeting as planned.

7.0 Program Focus Groups

7.1 Focus Groups Updates

Mr. Murtha provided an update on the work of the Transit, RTOC and Bike/Ped Program Focus Groups, saying that the ROTC would be meeting the following week and the others had recently met. He reported that all are discussing performance measures. Chairman Patronsky provided an update on the work of the Direct Emissions Reduction Program (DER) Focus Group, and noted that they are focusing on sustainability, livability and system modernization.

All groups believe that their processes worked well for the FFY 12-16 program and expect to use similar processes during the next call for projects, with clearer language about these processes included in the application materials. The focus group work is starting much earlier in this round as suggested in the lessons learned exercise.

7.2 Use of Focus Groups in Selecting Contingency Projects

Mr. Patronsky led a discussion based on a question raised at the June 15 Transportation Committee meeting as to what role (if any) the Focus Groups would have in selecting contingency projects if the need for contingency projects arises. The consensus was that these groups give their input on project priorities at programming time, and further input is unlikely.

There was no other business.

10.0 Next Meeting

The committee's next meeting is scheduled for August 23, 2012 at 2:00 p.m. The meeting date was subsequently changed to August 28 at 2:00 p.m.

Ten projects have submitted requests for changes. Four projects are requesting cost increases totaling \$2,607,266 (\$2,085,813 federal). One project is requesting to have its funding restored from deferred status in the amount of \$791,419 (663,135 federal). Two projects are requesting to fund phases at 100% funding levels. One project is requesting to be moved from the Multi-year B list into the active program in the amount of \$3,925,000 (\$3,925,000 federal). Two projects withdrew funding from their projects in the amount of \$806,250 (\$645,000 federal) which were handled as administrative modifications. The sponsors' requests are attached.

For Committee Consideration:

Lake County DOT – Washington St/CH A22 at CN/Metra Crossing (TIP ID 10-08-0031) The sponsor is requesting an increase to 100 percent funding for construction (including CE). The project was programmed in the FY 2012-2016 program for construction in the amount of \$21,174,000 (\$16,939,000 federal). The increase in funding percentage would increase construction by \$4,235,000 federal. The project is currently in Phase II engineering and is on schedule for a 2013 letting.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee: Table pending congressional action to restore capacity to fund CMAQ projects at 100 % federal level beyond September 30, 2012.

Elk Grove – Busse Woods Trail Overpass (CMAQ ID BP03123695) (TIP ID 03-10-0005) The sponsor is requesting to have this project moved from the CMAQ B list into the FFY 2013 program year. Currently the construction phase for this project is on the CMAQ B list. The sponsor is also requesting an increase to 100 percent funding for construction (including CE). The requested amount is \$3,925,000 federal. Since this project is currently not in the CMAQ FY 2012-2016 program the cost increase would be \$3,925,000 The project rank 52nd out of 112 FY2012-2016 bicycle facility proposals. The project was recommended by the Bicycle and Pedestrian Task Force and was included in the Multi-year B list.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee: Table the consideration of the request due to lack of available funding at this time.

Algonquin – Randall Rd Pedestrian Crossing Bridge (TIP ID 11-12-0006)

The sponsor is requesting an increase to 100 percent funding for the phase II engineering, Right of Way (ROW) acquisition, and construction (including CE) phases and to use local funds for phase I engineering instead of the CMAQ funds that are currently programmed for this phase. The project was programmed in the FY 2012-2016 program for phase I engineering in the amount of \$150,000 (\$120,000 federal), for phase II engineering in the amount of \$150,000 (\$120,000 federal), for phase II engineering in the amount of \$150,000 (\$120,000 federal), for phase II engineering in the amount of \$150,000 (\$120,000 federal), and construction (including CE) in the amount of \$3,250,000 (\$2,600,000 federal).

The sponsor would like to decrease by \$120,000 federal the CMAQ funding for phase I engineering. The increases in funding percentage would increase phase II engineering by \$30,000 federal, ROW by \$80,000 federal, and Construction/CE by \$650,000 federal for a total increase of \$760,000 federal. Phase II engineering and ROW are both programed for FY 2014 with construction /CE programmed in 2015.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee: Table pending congressional action to restore capacity to fund CMAQ projects at 100 % federal level beyond September 30, 2012.

Kane County DOT - Burlington Rd at IL 47 (TIP ID 09-06-0068)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase in the amount of \$1,250,000 (\$1,000,000 federal) for construction (including CE). The project was programmed in FY 2007 for \$1,060,000 total (\$848,000 federal) for construction of a roundabout for the intersection improvement at Burlington Rd and IL 47.

Phase I engineering has been completed and the project is currently in phase II engineering with a target letting date of 1/18/2013. The cost increase is being sought due to revised cost estimates for construction.

A re-ranking was completed and the project's rank among FY 2007 Intersection Improvements proposals remained unchanged at 6th.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee: Consider approval of the cost change of \$1,250,000 (\$1,000,000 federal) for a total project cost of \$2,520,000 (\$2,016,000 federal).

Cook County Department of Environmental Control – Cook County Fleet Diesel Retrofit (TIP ID 13-09-0001)

The sponsor is requesting to have \$663,135 in CMAQ funding that was put on the deferred list reinstated for this project. The sponsor does have a local agency agreement with IDOT and they have stated that upon having the funding for this project phase restored they are prepared to obligate the funds in September 2012 with implementation occurring in December 2012. The reason the project was delayed was due to difficulties securing local match. The Department of Environmental Control has worked with the Department of Highways to secure MFT funds for use as local match. Total funding for this project should these funds be restored would be \$828,919 (\$663,135 federal). The funding for the project was automatically deferred with the CMAP Board and Policy Committee approval of the new Programming and Management Policies in June.

The project was originally program in FY 2009 in the amount of \$633,873 (federal) and in FY 2010 in the amount of \$582,738 (federal). In 2011 the scope of the project was reduced in number of vehicles and \$553,476 (federal) was withdrawn.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee: Consider restoring CMAQ funding for the project in the amount of \$663,135 that was deferred for a total project cost of \$828,919 (\$663,135 federal).

Tinley Park – 183rd St at Oak Park Ave (TIP ID 07-10-0001)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase in the amount of \$100,000 (\$80,000 federal) for phase I engineering. The project was programmed in FY 2010-2011 cycle for phase I engineering in the amount of \$180,000 (\$144,000 federal) in FY 2011, phase II engineering in the amount of \$180,000 (\$144,000 federal) in FY 2011, phase II engineering in the amount of \$180,000 (\$144,000 federal) in FY 2012, ROW acquisition in the amount of \$400,000 (\$3210,000 federal) in FY 2013 and construction in the amount of \$2,000,000 (\$1,600,000 federal) for a roundabout (intersection improvement) at 183rd St and Oak Park Ave. The increase is the result of additional design requirements associated with designing a roundabout for this project. The cost increase will enable the remaining phase I engineering work to be completed.

A re-ranking was completed and the project's rank among FY 2010 intersection improvement proposals remained unchanged at 11th.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee: Consider approval of the cost change of \$100,000 (\$80,000 federal) for a total project cost of \$2,860,000 (\$2,288,000 federal).

Oswego - Mill Rd Multi-use Path (TIP ID 09-12-0008)

The sponsor is requesting a scope change and a cost increase. The sponsor is requesting to change the eastern limits for the multi-use path to be constructed as part of this project from Orchard Rd to Fox Chase Rd. to Orchard Rd to just east of IL 31. This is being done at the direction of IDOT. Additionally the sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$119,776 (\$95,813)

federal). The project was programmed in FY 2012 for phase II engineering in the amount of \$50,000 (\$40,000 federal) and construction in the amount of \$238,000 (\$190,400 federal). The cost increase being sought is a result of an IDOT requirement to complete a full phase I PDR, updated cost estimates and the scope change.

A re-ranking was completed and the project's rank among FY 2012 bicycle facilities proposals dropped from 23rd to 34th.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee: Consider approval of the scope change extending the eastern limits of this project from Fox Chase Rd to east of IL 31 and a cost change of \$113,516 (\$90,813 federal) for a total project cost of \$407,766 (\$326,213 federal).

Elmhurst - IL 56/Butterfield Rd at Commonwealth Ln (08-09-0011)

The sponsor is requesting to that ROW acquisition being included as a CMAQ eligible phase which would be paid for with a transfer \$95,000 (\$76,000 federal) from construction phase. Originally ROW acquisition was going to be paid for out of local funds. The cost of ROW acquisition has increased to the point that the sponsor would like to use CMAQ funds for ROW acquisition. Currently there is \$471,475 (\$377,180 federal) programmed for construction. There is also \$958,000 in STP-L funds for construction. The sponsor is not asking for a cost increase.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee: Consider approval of inclusion of ROW acquisition phase as an eligible phase with funds transferred from Construction in the amount of \$95,000 (\$76,000 federal) for a total project cost of \$471,475 (\$377,180 federal).

McHenry - IL 31 from McCullom Lake Rd to IL 120 (TIP ID 11-03-0007)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase in the amount of \$1,137,500 (\$910,000 federal) for construction (including CE). The project was programmed in 2005 for phase I and II engineering, ROW acquisition and construction in the amount of \$7,350,000 (\$2,540,000 federal) for the intersection improvement at IL 31 from McCullom Lake Rd to IL 120. The increase being sought is the result of revised cost estimates and inflation. This project has a target letting date of November 2012.

The project has programmed funds in the amount of \$1.2 million (federal) for ROW acquisition. The ROW acquisition is currently being handled by IDOT and the programmed funds are being used for Construction.

A re-ranking was completed and the project's rank among FY 2005 intersection improvement proposals remained unchanged at 2nd.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee: Consider approval of the cost change of \$2,637,500 (\$2,110,000 federal) for a total project cost of \$10,120,000 (\$4,650,000 federal).

Administrative Modifications:

Kane County – Fabyan Parkway from Nagle Blvd to IL 25 (TIP ID 09-10-0003)

The sponsor is withdrawing CMAQ funding for the ROW phase of this project in the amount of \$204,000 federal. This phase of the project will now be completed using local funds. Staff undertook this as an administrative modification.

Kane County - Main St. at Nelson Lake (TIP ID 09-08-0003)

The sponsor is withdrawing CMAQ funding for the ROW and phase II engineering phases of this project in the amount of \$441,000 federal. This is due to decreased cost estimates. Staff undertook this as an administrative modification.

Dear Mr. Patronsky:

The Village has successfully completed the preliminary engineering studies for the subject project and was pleased to have received design approval on June 28, 2012. The Village Board has authorized the preparation of contract plans and documents (Phase 2), and anticipates authorization to proceed from IDOT shortly this month. Construction of the much needed bicycle overpass for the Busse Woods Trail system is targeted for Spring 2013.

The project provides a safe crossing of Illinois Route 72 (Higgins Road) along the highly travelled Busse Woods path and provides a direct link to a Northwest Municipal Conference regional bicycle corridor. The project will eliminate bicycle and pedestrian conflicts with vehicles at the adjacent interchange with I-290. In 2007, the CMAQ Project Selection Committee (PSC) awarded Kane County Division of Transportation (KDOT) a total of \$1,016,000 for the Burlington Road at IL 47 Intersection Improvement/Roundabout Project (see Table 1 below). To date, Phase I Engineering has been completed and Phase II Engineering is nearing completion. The current construction cost estimate is \$2,100,000, which along with Phase III Engineering of \$210,000, totals \$2,310,000.

In anticipation of a January 18, 2013 letting date, Kane County is requesting the CMAQ PSC's consideration of a funding increase. An additional \$1,000,000 is requested in order to fund 80% of the construction and construction engineering costs. If approved, the total CMAQ funding allocation for this project would increase to \$2,016,000.

Phase I Preliminary Design Engineering is currently underway for the roundabout improvement at the intersection of 183rd Street and Oak Park Avenue in the Village of Tinley Park. As part of the Phase I Engineering we have been working with IDOT District 1, to obtain approval of the Intersection Design Study (IDS). Since roundabouts are new to Illinois, IDOT is taking the opportunity to use this project (as well as a few other Roundabouts submitted by various consulting firms) to develop the necessary design standards and requirements for this type of improvement. The IDS has been submitted several times and returned with numerous labor intensive review comments. This extensive review process was unanticipated by the Village, and has expended the engineering budget. Although the Village has already completed numerous Phase I Engineering tasks, there are still elements to be completed including a drainage study, public involvement and the Project Development Report. The Village is therefore requesting an additional \$80,000 for a total of \$224,000 in federal CMAQ funds to complete the Phase I Preliminary Design Engineering.

This letter is being written on behalf of our client, the Village of Oswego, to request approval of an extension of the limits of the Mill Road Multi-Use Path Improvement Project, along with a corresponding cost increase of \$90,813 in CMAQ funds (\$117,766 total increase).

It is our understanding that the next meeting of the CMAQ Project Selection Committee is scheduled for August 23, 2012, and we ask that this request be placed on that meetings' agenda for consideration.

BACKGROUND

On April 5, 2012, the first IDOT/FHWA Coordination meeting was attended by representatives from IDOT, FHWA, and HR Green. At that meeting there were several items discussed which result in this request for project extension and funding increase. These items are as follows:

- It was determined that the full extents of right-of-way necessary to construct the project are not currently fully dedicated to the Village, as was previously thought, as right-of-way is lacking along one parcel for a distance of approximately 800 feet. Due to this, IDOT is directing that a full Phase I Project Development Report (PDR) be prepared for the project corridor, which was not previously included in the project scope.
- The limits of the improvements current funded with CMAQ funds include the path from Orchard Road to Fox Chase Drive. IDOT directed that the Phase I PDR be completed from Orchard Road to Illinois Route 31, extending the logical termini eastward from Fox Chase Drive to the east side of Illinois Route 31, an additional distance of approximately 500 feet.
- The extended path will cross Illinois Route 31, requiring upgrades to existing traffic signals, in order to make a connection to an existing multi-use path approximately 75 feet east of Illinois Route 31, which will be the new termini of the proposed project.

In addition, topographic survey work has been completed for the original project extents. This information has facilitated a refinement of the original project cost estimate, and this updated cost estimate takes into account minor increases in earthwork necessary to complete the path as contemplated.

The City of Elmhurst would like to request that \$76,000 of the \$377,180 in CMAQ funding for this project be transferred from Construction to Right-of-Way (ROW). While completing the Phase 1 Engineering it was determined that the ROW costs increased above the original \$35,000 estimate. Initially, an adjacent hospital had hoped the project could be completed quicker by working with the City to cover ROW themselves. Thus there is no request for CMAQ funding on the application. But with the cost increase, the City and hospital decided they'd rather use CMAQ funds. The City is not requesting more CMAQ funds. The City has also received \$958,000 in STP funds for construction through the DuPage Mayors and Managers Conference.

The Thorn Creek Bicycle Trail Completion project is a proposed bike trail project located in southern Cook County. The project consists of completing two existing gaps in the Thorn Creek Trail system. The first begins at 26th Street in Chicago Heights north and continues northeastward to the existing trail at Joe Orr Road and the second begins at the existing trail at Chicago Heights/Glenwood Road and then continues northeast to 183rd Street and Cottage Grove. Completion of these two segments would close a significant gap in the Grand Illinois Trail.

The District applied for and received federal CMAQ dollars in the FY 2007 program. The amount of dollars received for construction and construction engineering was \$3,805,055. It should be noted that CMAQ dollars were also received for Phase 1 Engineering (which is now complete) and Phase 2 Engineering which is expected to be complete by the end of 2012.

However, due to the Phase I Engineering studies that were conducted, the estimated construction cost has increased due to a number of reasons. Two additional bridges are now part of the project. After refinement of the alignment of the proposed trail, it became apparent that the bridges were needed to cross over existing streams and flood plains. A significant amount of modular block retaining wall is also necessary to avoid impacts to trees and other sensitive environmental areas. Finally, it has been several years since the initial cost estimate was prepared. As a result, prices have increased, contributing to the higher current construction cost estimate. The current estimate construction cost, including construction engineering, is \$6,153,000.

The Forest Preserve District of Cook County recently received Phase I Design Approval for this project. The Phase 2 Engineering and Local Agency Agreements have been executed and are currently in Springfield for processing. Notice to Proceed is anticipated to be received sometime next month. Coordination has already taken place with the Corps of Engineers regarding several small wetland impacts with the project. Mitigation will be provided by purchasing credits in a wetland bank. An Illinois Commerce Commission Order has also been

received for the proposed bridge over the Union Pacific Railroad tracks. Therefore, the District is on target for a January, 2013 Letting with the Illinois Department of Transportation.

Due to the increase construction cost for the project, The Forest Preserve District is requesting that CMAQ funding for the project be increased from the current \$3,805,055 to \$4,922,400, which represents an increase of \$1,117,345. Approval of this requested increase in funding would ensure that the entire project will be completed in 2013. With the importance of this project as it relates to the Grand Illinois Trail and the Millennium Reserve, we look forward to your favorable action.

Staff conducted the 2nd quarter of 2012 Transit Expenditure Update. This effort is intended to track transit project expenditures after each project has been obligated. Of the 44 transit projects reported on this quarter, 12 are complete, but not yet closed out. Fourteen projects have not expended any CMAQ funds yet. The table below summarizes the agencies' responses and provides federal dollars expended, unexpended balances, and the percent of obligated CMAQ funds expended on each agency's projects (excluding completed projects) to show the degree to which active projects are yet to be undertaken.

Summary of CMAQ Transit Project Expenditures Updates – 2nd Quarter 2012

* Funds are shown in Federal dollars.

For nine projects, the schedule for completion remains unclear. Eight of the nine projects labeled stalled/unclear were also identified in the last few updates.

The delayed projects are:

- CTA-111th St and 115th St Split Route Service (TIP ID 16-09-0003) for \$400,000 FY 2009
- CTA- Purple Line Weekend Express Service (TIP ID 16-10-0005) for \$361,708 FY 2010
 - The CTA is having difficulty identifying local match on both, but still hopes to complete the projects. The agency informed the committee last summer that they would need more time.
- CTA- Suburban Station Bike Parking (TIP ID 13-10-0001) for \$19,200 FY 2010
 - This project has been stalled by staff reductions, but the CTA is currently pursing local municipal contacts to coordinate with existing bike parking projects near CTA stations.
- CDOT-Carroll Avenue Busway (TIP ID 01-04-0004) for \$1.6 million FY 2004
 - The City is planning to submit a request to the CMAQ Committee to re-scope the project (remaining funds = approx. \$1.588 million)
- Metra-GenSets Installation on Switch Engines (TIP ID 13-10-0007) for \$2.8 million -FY 2012
 - Metra is in discussions w/ RTA regarding sharing in the local match.
 - Metra-Grayland Station Parking (TIP ID 18-04-0561) for \$408,000 million FY 2011
 - Metra's FTA grant agreement has been slow to get executed.

The final three are commuter parking projects whose next implementation steps are under the control of the local governments:

- Metra-Glen Ellyn Station Parking ROW & Construction (TIP ID 18-99-0566) for \$624,000

 FY 1999
 - The village is currently undertaking design. Metra has not received a timeline for land acquisition and construction activities.
- Metra-Great Lakes Station Parking Construction only (TIP ID 18-03-355) for \$280,000 FY 2003
 - Held up by Union Pacific land acquisition issues.
- Metra-Cary Station Parking Construction only (TIP ID 11-05-0001) for \$148,000 FY 2006
 - \circ $\:$ In design phase. The Construction is on hold by the Village.
