## **A.** Transition Committee - Nigel F. Telman, Chair

A preliminary copy of the letter and brochure was distributed to the committee and is scheduled to be mailed out by Friday using the mailing lists of NIPC and CATS. In regards to public relations issues the committee has been examining brand issue including whether or not the organization should maintain the name "Regional Planning Board". The committee invited feedback from the full board on this matter and Karen Greenbaum suggested making the initial decision of "Northeastern Illinois" or

"Chicago Area". There was an informal vote amongst the board; it was close to split with minor favor to Northeastern Illinois. The committee will seek further input.

# C. Planning & Priorities Committee - President Al Larson, Chair The committee met on March 8 and continued to gather information on existing regional planning efforts. Don Kopec gave a synopsis on CATS programs and current efforts. Ron Thomas gave a summary of lengthy initiatives and goals of NIPC. The committee will continue the effort to become acquainted with planning initiatives.

Pete of MPC asked Member Hartstein if the Public Participation Committee is seeking a certain number of people for the Citizen's Advisory Commission. Subcommittee Chairman Hartstein responded no but the committee will be coming back with recommendations.
