We have reviewed the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) amendment request you submitted via correspondence dated March 9, 2015. The request adds projects pursuant to changes made to the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning.

The amended TIP has been endorsed by the appropriate Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO). The public transportation projects listed in the TIP amendment report provided are eligible for FTA funding.

We have determined that the amendments to the TIP and STIP for public transportation projects are financially constrained and consistent with the relevant MPO and statewide transportation plans. The projects were developed in accordance with the requirements of 23 CFR 450, and are exempt from the air quality conformity determination process. The project additions are approved for the FY2014-2019 STIP.
