**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM
(ITS) ARCHITECTURE V.2 FOR NORTHEASTERN ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Committee is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for northeastern Illinois, designated by the Governor and northeastern Illinois officials as being responsible, together with the state of Illinois for carrying out the provisions of 23 U.S. Code 134 and 49 U.S. Code 5303-06 for seven counties in northeastern Illinois and parts of Grundy County; and

WHEREAS, the Northeastern Illinois Regional ITS Architecture was developed and updated in accordance with U.S. Department of Transportation policies and procedures for implementing section 5206(e) of the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21), Public Law 105-178, 112 Stat. 457, and section 5307 of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act (SAFETEA-LU), pertaining to conformance with the National Intelligent Transportation Systems Architecture and Standards; and

WHEREAS, conformance with the National ITS Architecture is interpreted to mean the use of the National ITS Architecture to develop a regional ITS architecture, and the subsequent adherence of all ITS projects to that regional ITS architecture; and

WHEREAS, development of the regional ITS architecture includes recommended elements identified in federal guidance on Regional ITS Architectures; and

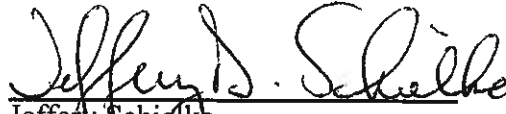
WHEREAS, the Regional ITS Architecture includes a maintenance plan to provide for updates as defined in 23 CFR 655, subpart F and 23 CFR 940 subchapter K; and

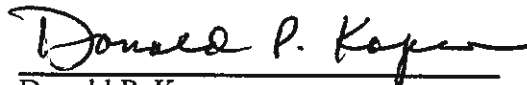
WHEREAS, development of the regional ITS architecture should be consistent with the transportation planning process for Statewide and Metropolitan Transportation Planning; and

NOW, THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT, the Metropolitan Planning Organization Policy Committee approves the Northeastern Illinois Regional ITS Architecture V.2; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Secretary of the Policy Committee is hereby authorized and directed to transmit certified copies of this resolution and document to the Governor of Illinois and, through the Illinois Department of Transportation, to the Division Administrator of the Federal Highway Administration and the Regional Administrator of the Federal Transit Administration.

The above and foregoing resolution is hereby adopted this 13th day of March 2008.
