



Advisory bike lanes

Advisory bike lanes are typically installed on narrow roadways with two-way vehicle traffic, low volume, and very low speeds. The lanes are marked by dashed white lines on both sides of the roadway, creating a single center lane for motor vehicles. When oncoming cars approach, the motorists move carefully into bike lanes to pass each other.
