5.1 Schaumburg – IL 62/Algonquin Rd (TIP ID 03-03-0102)

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to reprogram right of way funds from FFY 2018 to FFY 2017 and construction/construction engineering funds from FFY 2019 to FFY 2018.

5.2 Cicero – Cicero Access to Transit Improvements (TIP ID 05-16-0003)

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to reprogram phase 2 engineering funds from FFY 2018 to FFY 2016 and construction/construction engineering funds from FFY 2019 to FFY 2017. ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the requested schedule change.

5.3 IEPA - Railserve\Ingredion Switcher Locomotive Engine Replacement (TIP ID 13-16-0001)

5.9 Blue Island – Cal-Sag Trail (Blue Island East Segment) (TIP ID 06-06-0061)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$1,011,000 federal (\$1,264,000 total) for construction in FFY 2016.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval to re-program the construction phase of this project, including the requested cost increase, with TAP-L funds.

5.10 IDOT - US 6/Southwest Hwy at Gougar Rd (TIP ID 12-12-0005)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$564,000 federal (\$1,244,000 total) for construction in FFY 2016. ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the requested cost increase.

5.11 IDOT - IL 38/Roosevelt Rd at Ardmore Av (TIP ID 08-12-0002)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$856,000 federal (\$1,070,000 total) for ROW and \$504,000 federal (\$630,000 total) for construction in FFY 2016

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the requested cost increase.

5.12 Midlothian - Midlothian Metra Station Area Access Improvements (TIP ID 07-16-0003)

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to reprogram the phase 2 engineering from FFY 2018 to FFY 2016 and the construction funds from FFY 2019 to FFY 2017.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the requested schedule change.

5.13 Elgin - Elgin CBD Bike Racks Program (TIP ID 09-12-0009)

The sponsor is requesting reinstatement of \$8,000 federal (\$10,000 total) deferred phase 2 engineering funds and an increase of \$4,000 federal (\$7,900 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2016. The sponsor is also requesting a reduction of \$4,000 federal (\$0 total) for construction, which remains deferred.

1.0 Call to Order

Chairman Patronsky called the meeting to order at 2:35 p.m.

2.0 Agenda Changes and Announcements

Chairman Patronsky announced that there was a change in agenda item 5.0 - Projects Changes and that an updated list of project changes were provided to the Committee.

3.0 Approval of Minutes – January 7, 2016

On a motion by President Rodeghier and a second by Mr. Pitstick and a vote of all ayes, the minutes of the January 7, 2016 meeting were approved as presented.

4.0 Program Monitoring

4.1 Project Programming Status Sheets

Mr. Ferguson reported that the recurring reports on the programming status of active and deferred line items were included in the meeting packet. He stated that they include changes since the last meeting of the CMAQ Project Selection Committee, updated authorizations, and updated project notes.

4.2 Programming Summary and Obligation Goal

Mr. Ferguson reported that the Programming Summary and Obligation Goals table shows that the region has obligated just over \$11.3M. He stated that the region is behind on meeting its \$123M obligation goal in FFY 2016.

4.3 Transit Expenditures Quarterly Update

Ms. Dixon reported that the Transit Project Expenditure Update memo shows that as of December 31, 2015, of the 41 transit projects reported on this quarter, one project was completed but not closed and 8 active projects have had no expenditures of CMAQ funds. She stated that about \$122M has been expended while a \$244M balance remains.

Mr. Snyder asked why transit projects do not seem to be moving and cited reasons may include project implementation phases in out years and FTA grants being approved and expended for the full project amount at one time. He suggested that the memo have more narrative explaining project statuses. Mr. Pitstick responded that two large transit projects are still in the engineering phases and that the implementation phases have the larger portions of funding and suggested that these funds may be obligated in out years. Chairman Patronsky resolved that staff will consider ways to represent transit expenditures to the Committee more clearly.

5.0 Project Changes

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that fifteen projects have submitted scope, cost, and schedule change requests for committee consideration and one project required an administrative modification.

5.1 CDOT – Safe Routes to High School (TIP ID 01-05-0001)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor is requesting reinstatement of Construction funds. Mr. Snyder asked if the project was off the deferral list because the local agency agreement was executed and Mr. Privett affirmed.

Mr. Snyder made a motion, seconded by Mr. Heffron, to approve the requested reinstatement. With a vote of all ayes, the motion carried.

5.2 FPD of Cook County – North Branch Bicycle Trail Extension (East Segment) (TIP ID 01-08-0001)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor is requesting a scope change to revise the project limits back to the original limits so that CMAQ funds can be used to supplement TAP funds.

Mr. Privett made a motion, seconded by Mr. Snyder, to approve the requested scope change. With a vote of all ayes, the motion carried.

5.3 Cook County DOTH – Old Orchard Rd from Harms to Skokie Blvd (new limits E of I-94/Edens Expy to W of IL 41/Skokie Blvd (TIP ID 02-97-0006)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor is requesting a schedule change from 2019 to 2017 for the ROW phase.

Mr. Snyder made a motion, seconded by Mr. Heffron, to approve the requested schedule change. With a vote of all ayes, the motion carried.

5.4 Evanston – Green Bay Rd Corridor Improvements (TIP ID 02-06-0034)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor is requesting a cost increase totaling \$1,315,000 federal (\$1,644,000 total) due to bids coming in higher than the engineer's estimate. Mr. Snyder requested to hear an explanation for the high cost increase. Mr. Nagar reported that the bids on this project came in high across the board. He stated that Green Bay Road is one of two major north/south routes in Evanston and described the corridor improvements. Mr. Nagar noted that multiple fund sources are being leveraged on the project and assured the Committee that the requested cost increase is only for the CMAQ-funded portion of the project. Mr. Reznicek surmised that the high bids compared to the engineer's estimate could be due to the location of the project being difficult to transport materials to and to the complexities of construction and staging. He stated that he and the city are not confident that rebidding the project will result in lower bids.

President Rodeghier made a motion, seconded by Mr. Snyder, to approve the requested cost increase. With a vote of all ayes, the motion carried.

5.5 Lincolnwood – Lincolnwood UP Rail Line/Weber Spur Bike/Multiuse Trail (TIP ID 02-10-0001)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that sponsor is requesting a cost increase totaling \$160,000 federal (\$200,000 total) due to additional safety requirements and waste removal.

Mr. Privett made a motion, seconded by President Rodeghier, to approve the requested cost increase. With a vote of all ayes, the motion carried.

5.6 Lincolnwood – Lincolnwood ComEd Utility ROW / Skokie Valley Bike/Multiuse Trail (TIP ID 02-10-0002)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor is requesting a cost increase totaling \$112,000 federal (\$140,000 total) due to additional safety requirements and waste removal.

Mr. Privett made a motion, seconded by President Rodeghier, to approve the cost increase. With a vote of all ayes, the motion carried.

5.7 IDOT – IL 68/Dundee Rd at McHenry Rd/Wheeling Rd and IL 83/Elmhurst Rd (TIP ID 03-12-0014)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor is requesting a cost increase totaling \$1,532,000 federal (\$1,915,000 total) due to higher land acquisition costs and higher construction costs.

Mr. Snyder made a motion, seconded by President Rodeghier, to approve the requested cost increase. With a vote of all ayes, the motion carried.

5.8 Schaumburg – Schaumburg Metra Station Bike Racks and Lockers (TIP ID 03-16-0001)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor is requesting a schedule change from 2018 to 2016. The project is on schedule for a local letting anticipated for July 2016.

Mr. Pitstick made a motion, seconded by Mr. Snyder, to approve the requested schedule change. With a vote of all ayes, the motion carried.

5.9 Bensenville - Church Rd from Jefferson St to Grand Av (TIP ID 08-11-0017) Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor is requesting a schedule change from 2018 to 2016. The project plans to be on the June 2016 letting.

Mr. Snyder made a motion, seconded by Mr. Heffron, to approve the requested schedule change. With a vote of all ayes, the motion carried.

5.10 FPD of DuPage County - Winfield Mounds Segment - West Branch Regional Trail (TIP ID 08-14-0002)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor is requesting a cost increase totaling \$147,000 federal (\$182,000 total) due to an increase in the length of a boardwalk. The project is targeting the July 2016 letting.

Mr. Ferguson said that this project is being recommended for transfer to the TAP program at the April 22, 2016 Transportation Committee, so no action from the Project Selection Committee is needed. In response to a question from Mr. Snyder he reaffirmed that the project currently does not have TAP funding but that the project is completing a missing segment of Regional Greenways and Trail Plan which is the major goal for the local TAP program. Mr. Donovan asked if other TAP projects would be removed from the program. Mr. Ferguson responded that other projects would just be moved into later years.

5.11 Glen Ellyn - Glen Ellyn Signalized Pedestrian Crossing Improvements (TIP ID 08-14-0003)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor is requesting a cost increase totaling \$23,817 federal (\$29,771 total) due to bids coming in higher than estimated.

Mr. Privett made a motion, seconded by Mr. Pitstick, to approve the requested cost change. With a vote of all ayes, the motion carried.

5.12 IDOT – IL 68/Dundee Rd at Buffalo Grove Rd (TIP ID 10-12-0005)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor is requesting a scope change to remove the dual left turn lanes from the project. The scope change results in a cost reduction in the amount of \$800,000 federal for the project.

Mr. Snyder made a motion, seconded by President Rodeghier, to approve the requested scope change. With a vote of all ayes, the motion carried.

5.13 Romeoville - Romeoville Metra Station and Parking (TIP ID 12-10-0001)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor is requesting reinstatement of Construction funds in the amount of \$35,200 federal (\$44,000 total) to proceed with utility work prior to construction of the station and parking lot. The project is targeting the November 4, 2016 letting.

President Rodeghier made a motion, seconded by Mr. Privett, to approve the requested reinstatement. With a vote of all ayes, the motion carried.

5.14 IEPA - Chicago Area Green Fleet Grant Program (TIP ID 13-14-0001)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor is requesting a schedule change from 2018 and 2019 to 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019. The amount for 2016 is \$1,000,000 federal (\$2,000,000 total) and for 2017, 2018 and 2019 is \$2,000,000 federal (\$4,000,000 total) each, which will allow the program to continue without a disruption in funding.

Mr. Heffron made a motion, seconded by Mr. Pitstick, to approve the requested schedule change. With a vote of all ayes, the motion carried.

5.15 Metra - Metra MD Locomotive Repowers (TIP ID 18-12-0006)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor is requesting a scope change from repowering two F40C locomotives to two F59PH locomotives.

Mr. Privett made a motion, seconded by Mr. Pitstick, to approve the requested scope change. With a vote of all ayes, the motion carried.

5.16 Lake County DOT - IL 120/Belvidere Rd from IL 134/Main St to US 45 (TIP ID 10-14-0008)

Mr. Pietrowiak reported that the sponsor for the project has changed from Lake County DOT to IDOT. Both parties have agreed to this change. Staff made the change as an administrative modification.

6.0 Program Development

Mr. Ferguson indicated that the next call for projects is scheduled for January of 2017. A memo regarding proposed changes for the FFY 2018-22 CMAQ Call for Projects was provided and staff gave a brief overview of the proposed changes.

Mr. Brown gave a presentation on an updated method of estimating air quality effectiveness of bicycle projects, specifically reduced auto usage by providing bicycle facilities. The new bicycle demand estimation tool forecasts use of proposed bicycle facilities based on mode shift due to bicycle level-of-service (BLOS) within a given project area. Mr. Privett stated that this presentation was recently given to CMAP's Bicycle and Pedestrian Task Force and some members are concerned about the underpinnings of BLOS. Mr. Snyder asked if this method could be validated by the Task Force before being presented to the Committee for approval. He said the demand estimation tool ought to come with endorsement from the Task Force.

Mr. Ferguson stated that the current method has not been updated for over 20 years and that members of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Task Force raised concerns with the current method back in 2006. Mr. Snyder asked to see a comparison of project rankings using both methods; Mr. Privett expressed misgivings with the data being used in the tool. Mr. Brown stated that staff will meet with members of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Task Force members in the following weeks to discuss calibration and validation of the new tool.

Mr. Heffron asked if adaptive signal control proposals would be modeled; Mr. Snyder asked if they could be evaluated after they are implemented so assumptions could be validated. Mr. Ferguson indicated that there was no official post project study planned for adaptive signal control proposals but would be reviewing the recently completed projects in Lake County. With so few projects programmed it would be difficult to do a proper validation.

Mr. Snyder asked if the enhance impact to sensitive population data for direct emission reduction proposals could be put into a map in time for the application cycle. Mr. Ferguson replied that this could be done.

Mr. Ferguson reported that staff proposes to update the transportation impact criteria to include the potential benefit to bus service in addition to the current criteria of travel time reliability, safety, and whether the project is on the Congestion Management Process (CMP) network. Mr. Snyder stated that the Regional Transportation Operations Coalition provided input to the current scoring criteria to establish a hierarchy of importance and suggested that the new evaluation method be presented to RTOC for endorsement. He noted that there is a low density of bus routes west of I-294, so projects in that part of the region would routinely lose 5% from their score. Mr. Ferguson indicated that he did not share that view of bus transit in the suburban market with concern to potentially eligible projects. In response to a question from Mr. Tomzik, Mr. Ferguson clarified that "highway" was not confined to limited-access facilities.

7.0 FAST

Mr. Donovan provided an update on changes to the CMAQ program under the FAST Act and noted that MAP-21 rulemaking continues. He reported that FHWA published final rules for HSIP and safety performance measures on March 15, 2016; final rules for metropolitan planning and bridge programs will be out by the end of the federal fiscal year. Final rules on performance measures of the NHS, freight system, and for CMAQ are expected be released next week for a 120-day comment period. Mr. Donovan stated that

formal guidance for CMAQ under FAST will not likely be published until after the MAP-21 rulemaking process. He noted that the CMAP region is probably already beyond the eventual national standards for CMAQ performance measurement.

8.0 Other Business

There was no other business.

9.0 Public Comment

There were no public comments.

10.0 Next Meeting

The committee's next meeting is scheduled for July 7, 2016 at 2:00 p.m.

For Committee Consideration:

Schaumburg – IL 62/Algonquin Rd (TIP ID 03-03-0102)

This project was approved for \$360,000 federal (\$450,000 total) for ROW in FFY 2018 and \$2,320,000 federal (\$2,900,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2019.

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to reprogram ROW funds from FFY 2018 to FFY 2017 and Construction/CE funds from FFY 2019 to FFY 2018. Phase I engineering is anticipated to be approved by the end of 2016.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the requested schedule change to reprogram \$360,000 federal (\$450,000 total) for ROW from FFY 2018 to FFY 2017 and \$2,320,000 federal (\$2,900,000 total) for construction/CE from FFY 2019 to FFY 2018 for Schaumburg – IL 62/Algonquin Rd (TIP ID 03-03-0102).

Cicero – Cicero Access to Transit Improvements (TIP ID 05-16-0003)

This project was approved for \$19,200 federal (\$24,000 total) for Phase 2 engineering in FFY 2018 and \$186,080 federal (\$232,600 total) for Construction/CE in FFY 2019.

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to reprogram Phase 2 engineering funds from FFY 2018 to FFY 2016 and Construction/CE funds from FFY 2019 to FFY 2017.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the requested schedule change to reprogram \$19,200 federal (\$24,000 total) for Phase 2 engineering from FFY 2018 to FFY 2016 and \$186,080 federal (\$232,600 total) for Construction/CE from FFY 2019 to FFY 2017 for Cicero – Cicero Access to Transit Improvements (TIP ID 05-16-0003).

IEPA - Railserve\Ingredion Switcher Locomotive Engine Replacement (TIP ID 13-16-0001)

This project was approved for \$2,698,300 federal (\$4,142,000 total) for implementation in FFY 2019.

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to reprogram implementation funds from FFY 2019 to FFY 2017.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the requested schedule change to reprogram \$2,698,300 federal (\$4,142,000 total) for implementation from FFY 2019 to FFY 2017 for IEPA - Railserve\Ingredion Switcher Locomotive Engine Replacement (TIP ID 13-16-0001).

Rosemont - Rosemont CTA Station Pedestrian Crossing (TIP ID 04-16-0001)

This project was approved for \$527,206 federal (\$659,008 total) for construction in FFY 2018.

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to reprogram the construction funds from FFY 2018 to FFY 2017. The project is targeting the November 4, 2016 letting.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the requested schedule change to reprogram \$527,206 federal (\$659,008 total) for construction from FFY 2018 to FFY 2017 for Rosemont - Rosemont CTA Station Pedestrian Crossing (TIP ID 04-16-0001).

University Park - University Park Metra Transit Access (TIP ID 07-16-0006)

The project was approved for \$36,000 federal (\$45,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2018 and \$357,400 federal (\$446,750 total) for construction in FFY 2019 as part of the RTA Access to Transit project.

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to reprogram the phase 2 engineering funds from FFY 2018 to FFY 2016. Federal authorization is pending committee approval and a TIP change.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the requested schedule change to reprogram \$36,000 federal (\$45,000 total) for phase 2 engineering from FFY 2018 to FFY 2016 for University Park - University Park Metra Transit Access (TIP ID 07-16-0006).

Richton Park - Richton Park Metra Electric Station Area Access (TIP ID 07-16-0005)

This project was approved for \$17,760 federal (\$22,200 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2018 and \$263,842 federal (\$329,803 total) for construction in FFY 2019 as part of the RTA Access to Transit project.

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to reprogram the phase 2 engineering funds from FFY 2018 to FFY 2016. Federal authorization is pending committee approval and a TIP change.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the requested schedule change to reprogram \$17,760 federal (\$22,200 total) for phase 2 engineering from FFY 2018 to FFY 2016 for Richton Park - Richton Park Metra Electric Station Area Access (TIP ID 07-16-0005).

Oak Forest - Oak Forest TOD Area Access to Transit Improvements (TIP ID 07-16-0004)

This project was approved for \$36,000 federal (\$45,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2018 and \$415,910 federal (\$519,887 total) for construction in FFY 2019 as part of the RTA Access to Transit project.

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to reprogram the phase 2 engineering funds from FFY 2018 to FFY 2016. Federal authorization is pending committee approval and a TIP change.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the requested schedule change to reprogram \$36,000 federal (\$45,000 total) for phase 2 engineering from FFY 2018 to FFY 2016 for Oak Forest TOD Area Access to Transit Improvements (TIP ID 07-16-0004).

Romeoville - Romeoville Metra Station and Parking (TIP ID 12-10-0001)

This project was approved for \$340,000 federal (\$555,769 total) for phase 1 engineering in FFY 2010, \$440,000 federal (\$756,250 total) for phase 2 engineering in 2011, \$2,840,000 federal (\$3,550,000 total) for construction/construction engineering of commuter parking in 2012, and \$812,000 federal (\$1,015,000 total) for construction/construction engineering of a new station in FFY 2013. Phase 2 engineering and construction were deferred in 2012 due to phase 1 engineering not being accomplished prior to sunsetting. Phase 2 engineering was reinstated and obligated in FFY 2015. \$35,200 federal (\$44,000 total) for construction was reinstated in April 2016 for advanced utility work.

The sponsor is requesting reinstatement of the remaining deferred construction/construction engineering funds and a cost increase of \$320,000 federal (\$400,000 total) in FFY 2017 due to Canadian National contracted flagging expenses. Pre-final plans were submitted to IDOT on April 22, 2016 and the project is currently targeting the November 4, 2016 letting.

A re-ranking was completed and the project ranking remained unchanged at 1st among all 2010 transit facility proposals.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the requested reinstatement of \$3,616,800 federal (\$4,521,000 total) and increase of \$320,000 federal (\$400,000 total) for construction/construction engineering in FFY 2016 for Romeoville - Romeoville Metra Station and Parking (TIP ID 12-10-0001).

Blue Island – Cal-Sag Trail (Blue Island East Segment) (TIP ID 06-06-0061)

This segment of the project was approved for \$1,521,000 federal (\$1,901,000 total) for construction/construction engineering in FFY 2014.

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$1,011,000 federal (\$1,264,000 total) for construction in FFY 2016 due to higher unit prices, increased earthwork due to alignment adjustments, and increased structural work and modification of the existing slope wall due to unforeseen geotechnical and alignment issues. The project is targeting the November 4, 2016 letting.

A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking changing from 17 to 19 among all 2014 bicycle facility proposals. The ranking among funded projects changed from 35 to 41. Nine funded projects remain ranked lower than Blue Island East Segment.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends consideration of re-programming the construction phase of this project, including the requested cost increase, with TAP-L funds. A more detailed discussion of the status of the TAP-L program will occur under agenda item 4.5.

IDOT - US 6/Southwest Hwy at Gougar Rd (TIP ID 12-12-0005)

This project was approved for \$160,000 federal (\$200,000 total) for right of way in FFY 2013 (authorized in FFY 2015) and \$800,000 federal (\$1,000,000 total) for construction in FFY 2014. An additional \$400,000 federal (\$500,000 total) for construction was approved in May 2013 and an additional \$272,000 federal (\$340,000 total) for construction was approved in January 2016, for a current total of \$1,472,000 federal (\$1,840,000 total) for construction.

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$564,000 federal (\$1,244,000 total) for construction in FFY 2016 due to increased landscape, drainage (not CMAQ funded), and safety items and detailed quantity calculations and current bid tab pricing. The project is targeting the September 16, 2016 state letting.

A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking changing from 44 to 55 among all 2012 intersection improvement proposals. The ranking among funded projects changed from 23 to 24. Eleven funded projects remain ranked lower than 24.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the requested cost increase of \$564,000 federal (\$1,244,000 total) for construction for IDOT - US 6/Southwest Hwy at Gougar Rd (TIP ID 12-12-0005).

IDOT - IL 38/Roosevelt Rd at Ardmore Av (TIP ID 08-12-0002)

This project was approved for \$160,000 federal (\$200,000 total) for right of way in FFY 2015 (authorized in FFY 2014) and \$400,000 federal (\$500,000 total) for construction in FFY 2016. An additional \$296,000 federal (\$370,000 total) was approved for construction in February 2014, for a current total of \$696,000 federal (\$870,000 total).

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$856,000 federal (\$1,070,000 total) for ROW based on final judgement order settlement costs and an additional \$504,000 federal (\$630,000 total) for construction in FFY 2016 due to updated roadway improvement, traffic signal, ADA, and traffic control plan costs. The project is targeting the September 16, 2016 state letting.

A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking changing from 54 to 72 among all 2012 intersection improvement proposals. The ranking among funded projects changed from 27 to 34. Four funded projects remain ranked lower than 34.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the requested increase of \$856,000 federal (\$1,070,000 total) for ROW and \$504,000 federal (\$630,000 total) for construction for IDOT - IL 38/Roosevelt Rd at Ardmore Av (TIP ID 08-12-0002).

Midlothian - Midlothian Metra Station Area Access Improvements (TIP ID 07-16-0003)

This project was approved for \$48,000 federal (\$60,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2018 and \$736,000 federal (\$920,000 total) for construction in FFY 2019 as part of the RTA Access to Transit project.

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to reprogram the phase 2 engineering from FFY 2018 to FFY 2016 and the construction funds from FFY 2019 to FFY 2017. Phase 2 engineering is anticipated to be authorized in August 2016 and the project is targeting the August 4, 2017 letting.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the requested schedule change to reprogram \$48,000 federal (\$60,000 total) for phase 2 engineering from FFY 2018 to FFY 2016 and to reprogram \$736,000 federal (\$920,000 total) for construction from FFY 2019 to FFY 2017 for Midlothian - Midlothian Metra Station Area Access Improvements (TIP ID 07-16-0003).

Elgin - Elgin CBD Bike Racks Program (TIP ID 09-12-0009)

This project was approved for \$8,000 federal (\$10,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2013 and \$68,800 federal (\$86,000 total) for construction in FFY 2013. The project was voluntarily deferred by the sponsor in October 2014.

The sponsor is requesting reinstatement of the deferred phase 2 engineering funds in FFY 2016, an increase of \$4,000 federal (\$7,900 total) for phase 2 engineering and a reduction of \$4,000 federal (\$0 total) for construction, resulting in an increase of \$0 federal (\$7,900 total) for the project. Federal authorization for phase 2 engineering is pending committee approval and a TIP change. Construction is anticipated to begin in March of 2017, and a request for reinstatement of those funds will be required once readiness is demonstrated by the submittal of pre-final plans to IDOT District 1.

A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking changing from 2 to 3 among all 2012 bicycle parking proposals. The ranking among funded projects changed from 2 to 3. Four funded projects remain ranked lower than 3.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the requested reinstatement of \$12,000 federal (\$17,900 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2016 and the reduction of \$4,000 federal (\$0 total) for the deferred construction phase for Elgin - Elgin CBD Bike Racks Program (TIP ID 09-12-0009).

RTA - Regional Transit Signal Priority (TSP) Integration Plan, Five Year Implementation: Priority Corridors (TIP ID 13-12-0002)

This project was approved for a total of \$32,000,000 federal (\$40,000,000 total) for engineering and implementation in FFY 2012 for TSP on 33 priority transit corridors spanning 400 miles of roadway and 1000 signalized intersections. Funds were obligated in an FTA grant in 2012.

The sponsor is requesting a reduction in the scope of the project to implement TSP on 13 priority transit corridors spanning 100 miles of roadway and 400 signalized intersections and approval to utilize funding for traffic signal modernization on the north and central portions of the Ashland Avenue Corridor (Irving Park Rd. to Cermak Rd.).

The sponsor provided updated emissions benefit information and staff calculated the revised \$ per kilogram of VOC eliminated to be \$865. The project ranking changed from 4 to 6 among all 2012 transit service and equipment proposals. The ranking among funded projects did not change at 2 with two funded projects remaining lower in the rankings.

The sponsor will give a brief update on the project under agenda item 6.0. Following the presentation, the committee will be requested to take action on the requested scope change.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the requested scope change to reduce the number of TSP routes and miles to 13 routes and 100 miles along with including the traffic signal modernization as an approved item in the scope.

Administrative Modifications

Tinley Park – 183rd St at Oak Park Ave (TIP ID 07-10-0001)

The sponsor requested the withdrawal of this project from the CMAQ program. Phase 1 and 2 engineering have been obligated but \$240,000 federal (\$300,000 total) for ROW and \$2,464,000 federal (\$3,080,000 total) for construction CE for a total of \$2,704,000 federal (\$3,380,000 total) has not been obligated and is deferred. Staff completed this request as an administrative modification.

Kane County DOT – Randall Rd Transit Infrastructure Improvements (TIP ID 09-14-0005) Kane County DOT has completed phase 2 engineering for the project using local funds, and is requesting to transfer sponsorship to Pace for construction. Pace has accepted the sponsorship of this project. Staff completed this request as an administrative modification.

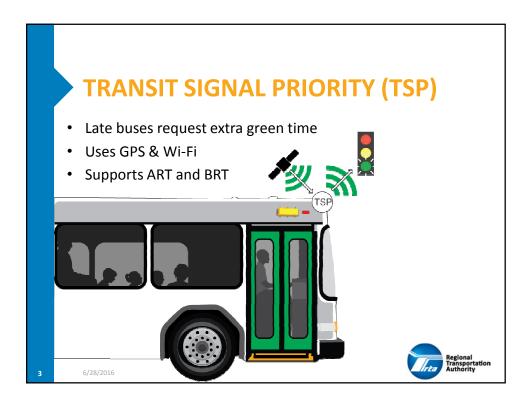

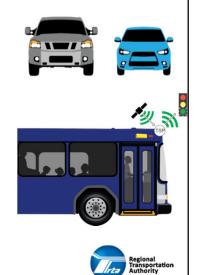

 - After TSP is operational

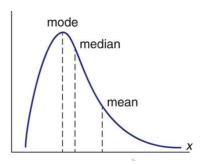

REGIONAL TSP PROGRAM



- Builds on previous TSP Demos in the region:
 - Cermak Road (IDOT, CTA, Pace) in 1997
 - Western Avenue (RTA, CTA, CDOT) in 2008-2010
 - Harvey Transp. Center (RTA, Pace, IDOT) in 2010-2011
 - Washington Street (Pace, Lake Co.) in 2014
 - Jeffrey Jump (CTA, CDOT) in 2014
- Need to develop & implement a regional program
- \$40 million CMAQ grant (90% federal, 10% RTA)
- · Plus other federal and local grants

GUIDING PRINCIPLES



- Interoperable System
 - Different transit and highway jurisdictions
 - Any bus, any traffic signal (properly equipped)
- Open Architecture
 - Industry standard communication protocols
 - Vendor neutral, off-the-shelf equipment
- Use Existing Equipment if possible
 - Bus Automatic Vehicle Location (AVL) systems
 - Traffic Signal Controllers
 - V-2-I, I-2-I and I-2-C Communication

REGIONAL TSP STANDARDS

- Vehicle-to-Intersection TSP Message Set
 - Defines the information communicated between the bus and the traffic signal controller
- 5.0 GHz Wi-Fi with 802.11n (or 802.11ac) protocol

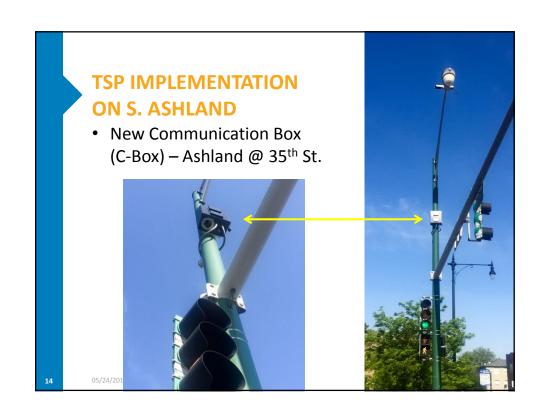
TSP IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE

- CTA/CDOT implementing TSP on S. Ashland Ave. in spring 2016 and on Western Ave. in late 2016
- North and Central Ashland Ave. require traffic signal modernization and will follow in 2017/2018
- Pace/IDOT have already optimized most signals
- Pace proof-of-concept test with IDOT, CDOT, and CTA in late 2016/early 2017 on Milwaukee Ave.
- Pace/IDOT to implement TSP on Milwaukee and 10 other corridors in 2017 and 2018
