CMAQ Project Selection Committee August 2, 2002 Meeting Agreements

- 1. CATS staff will review the evaluation method for proposals that involve signalizing stop sign-controlled intersections.
- 2. Additional information provided by project sponsors will be reviewed and incorporated into the ranking sheets as appropriate.
- 3. CATS staff will review discussions regarding funding of the Salt Creek Greenway.
- 4. Updated rankings will be posted to the CATS Web site on August 9. Rankings by cost per ton of VOC eliminated, cost per thousand trips eliminated, cost per ton of NOx eliminated and cost per 1000 VMT eliminated will be available.
- 5. Efforts will continue to obtain a positive eligibility determination on station improvement projects.
- 6. A link to the TRB Special Report 264 The Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program: Assessing 10 Years of Experience" which features CATS as one of its case studies will be posted on the CATS Web site.
- 7. The annual follow up on programmed CMAQ projects will commence in August with additional information sought on projects with funds transferred to FTA based on discussions with implementers and FTA.
- 8. The next meeting will be Friday August 30, 2002 at 9:00 a.m. in the CATS conference room. Subsequent to the meeting, the next meeting date was rescheduled for **Tuesday**, **September 3 at 1:00 p.m.**
