5.1 Des Plaines -Ballard Road from Bender Road to Good Avenue (TIP ID 03-12-0005)

The sponsor is requesting reinstatement of \$453,000 federal (\$567,000 total) in construction funds and a cost change to fund construction engineering locally.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the requested reinstatement and cost change.

5.2 Bensenville – IL 83 from Bryn Mawr Ave to Foster Ave (TIP ID 08-16-0001)

The sponsor is requesting to transfer \$32,000 federal (\$40,000 total) from phase II engineering to construction.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the requested transfer.

5.3 Bensenville – Railroad Avenue/Metra Station Access Improvements (TIP ID 08-17-0026)

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to move \$400,000 federal (\$500,000 total) for construction from FFY 2022 to FFY 2018.

5.4 Lake County – Washington Street at CN/Metra Crossing (TIP ID 10-08-0031)

1.0 Call to Order

Mr. Ferguson called the meeting to order at 2:05 p.m.

2.0 Agenda Changes and Announcements

Mr. Ferguson noted that to his knowledge there were no agenda changes.

3.0 Approval of Minutes – September 14, 2017

On a motion by Mr. Schmidt and seconded by Mr. Pitstick, the minutes of the September 14, 2017 meeting were approved.

4.0 Program Monitoring

4.1 Project Programming Status Sheets

Mr. Ferguson reported that staff is in the process of finalizing the October status updates and reprogramming projects. He also noted that staff is discussing the potential managing projects almost exclusively through eTIP.

4.2 Programming Summary and Obligation Goal

Mr. Ferguson made note of the programming summary and obligation goal chart in the adjoining packet that shows an over programed balance. He stated that it is suspected that the issue will resolve itself as staff attends to the matter. He noted that some numbers from the TIP were used to calculate the unobligated portion of the balance; adjustments that were made would drop the balance by \$20 million.

Mr. Ferguson continued by stating that an obligation goal for 2018 was established. He described the process as taking half of the unobligated balance from the

previous year and appended that amount to the annual allotment. This was done to account for under obligation from the previous year. Mr. Ferguson further noted that he would at a minimum have the yearly allotment spent on an annual basis.

A motion to approve the obligation was made by Mr. Schmidt and seconded by Mr. Pitstick. The motion passed.

5.0 Project Changes

5.1 IDOT — Cumberland Circle Improvement (IL 58/Golf Rd at Wolf Rd) (TIP ID 03-14-0004)

Ms. Maddux reported that IDOT is requesting a cost increase of \$80,000 federal (\$100,000 total) for right of way and \$930,000 federal (\$2 million total) for construction due to increased land acquisition and construction costs. Ms. Maddux stated that staff recommends approval of the proposed changes. On a motion made by Mr. Privett and seconded by Ms. Karry, the motion was passed.

6.0 CMAQ Performance Measures Update

Mr. Ferguson presented the memo included with the meeting materials that outlined system performance and congestion measures performance measures for the CMAQ as required by FHWA. The final rule was put in place in May that mandates IDOT and CMAQ must develop targets for the CMAQ related performance measures and submit them to FHWA. CMAP plans to develop measures in conjunction with IDOT and NWIRPC which is part of the northeastern Illinois non-attainment area. The draft targets will need to be completed for the region by October 1, 2018 and staff intendeds to include them as part of the draft release of the ON TO 2050 plan.

Mr. Ferguson continued by mentioning that there are three different areas that must be addressed in terms of performance based measures and targets for CMAQ: peak hour excessive delay, non-SOV travel, on road mobile sources. One additional piece to be acted upon that was called under MAP-21 and FAST Act was a performance plan. He stated that the plan includes the aforementioned targets and the projects that will help to meet those targets over 2 year and 4 year time periods. This performance plan must later be updated on a regular, two year basis and then submitted to IDOT.

Staff will be working on the performance measures and targets over the next six months and will be coming back to the Project Selection Committee with proposed targets for their review prior to releasing them with the draft plan in June.

7.0 CMAQ/TAP-L Program Development

7.1 FFY 2018-2022 CMAQ and FFY 2018-2020 TAP-L

Mr. Ferguson stated that the programs were approved by the CMAP Board and the MPO Policy Committee and are waiting on the eligible determination from FHWA and FTA. The notification of sponsors will be done as soon as eligibility determination is confirmed. He added that an initiation meeting is scheduled to be held at IDOT offices on December 13.

7.2 Next Call for Projects

Mr. Ferguson stated that staff has already been investigating different ways with which to improve future calls for projects, whether they be changes to the analyses or the program development process. He invited committee members to provide any input advance of the next call which is scheduled for the January 2019 timeframe.

Mr. Sullivan inquired about the language being used in the booklet pertaining to the performance measures. Mr. Ferguson responded by saying that he does not believe that any language pertaining to specifics will be included in the call for projects. He mentioned that meeting a specific goal can be included if the need to shape or steer the program in a certain direction should arise.

Mr. Privett added that there may need to be some sort of tie in between the analysis performed on traffic related projects and the peak hour excessive delay measure. He inquired whether the existing process could assist in finding the peak hour excessive delay for on road projects. He urged members to consider the process in order to have a scoring mechanism that focuses calls that address all three performance options.

Ms. Karry shared several comments from Lake County staff members with concerns about the Travel Time Reliability map, the local 5% Crash Location map and the Congestion Management Process (CMP) map. Concerns were also expressed about the measurement of speed improvements for intersection improvement projects versus delay, and the fact that TAP scoring does not account for cost.

8.0 2018 Meeting Schedule

Mr. Ferguson stated that the proposed meeting dates for 2018 are included on the agenda for the consideration of the committee. He noted that staff had arranged these meeting dates based on the Transportation Committee meeting schedule and the IDOT letting dates.

On a motion made by Ms. Karry and seconded by Mr. Schmidt, the 2018 proposed meeting schedule was approved.

9.0 Other Business

Mr. Privett stated that the reason Deputy Commissioner Hamilton was not in attendance at today's meeting, was she was attending the National Association of City Transportation Officials conference. She is talking about projects funded through CMAQ and bringing awareness to benefits of these projects.

Re: October 2017 CMAQ and TAP-L Status Updates

CMAQ and TAP-L Programming and Management Policies call for semi-annual updates to determine the progress that projects are making towards both the obligation of federal funds and the accomplishment of Active Program Management milestones. Status update responses are used to reprogram line items into appropriate federal fiscal years, to record accomplishments, and to determine projects for deferral.

In October 2017, status updates were requested for 209 individual project phases from 116 distinct projects and a total programmed amount of \$547.1 million. These project phases were either programmed in FFY 2017 or earlier and have not been accomplished. Status updates were also requested for project phases programmed in FFY 2018 and 2019 and all phases that are currently considered deferred. Details regarding the disposition of the line items and analysis of the status update responses, including funding amounts, fiscal year changes, and reasons for delay, are provided in this memo.

Of the 209 project phases for which status updates were requested, 49 were deferred (\$74.1 million), 12 were subject to sunset (\$27.2 million), 40 were federally authorized before September 30, 2017 but not yet accomplished (\$34.5 million), 43 were programmed in 2017 or earlier and were not yet federally authorized (\$102.2 million), and 65 were programmed in 2018 or beyond (\$309.1 million).

Updates were received for 98% of the requests. Fourteen project phases for which updates were requested were accomplished (\$20.7 million).

Of the twelve project phases set to sunset at the end of 2017, one was accomplished and two withdrawn due to right of way no longer being needed. Nine project phases (\$27.1 million) subject to sunset in 2017 did not obligate funds nor meet the accomplishment milestone; three (\$13.9 million) were deferred as a result and the remaining six (\$13.2 million) are construction phases scheduled to be let in early 2018.

Of 54 project phases (\$126.9 million) programmed in 2017 that were not subject to sunset, nine were accomplished (\$20.3 million), 38 (\$76.9 million) expect to be federally authorized and accomplished in 2018, and the remaining seven (\$29.8 million) are anticipated to be delayed beyond 2018.

Strikingly, 73 of the 93 active project phases programmed in 2017 or earlier (78%, \$136.6 million) indicated a delay preventing accomplishment. This rate of delay can attest to the unusually low obligation rate in FFY 2017. The tables below illustrate the distribution of the delayed project line items by sponsor group and type of delay reported.

Status updates were also requested for 41 project phases (\$155.4 million) programmed in 2018 to be proactive in accomplishing the FFY 2018 obligation goal and to assist with predicting the obligating authority that will be needed beyond the current year of the program. Of these, 33 phases (\$78.8 million) indicated no delay or that they expect to obligate funds in 2018. The remaining eight (\$76.6 million) are still on schedule for completion prior to sunsetting but were reprogrammed in later years based on the expected obligation year provided in the update response.

In all, 53 active and 26 deferred project phases were reprogrammed to different federal fiscal years based on expected years of federal authorization. Details of individual line item changes and status update notes are included in the Program Summary Reports distributed with the January 4, 2018 PSC agenda packet. The net changes are as follows:

Looking forward, status updates indicated that sponsors expect \$82.1 million programmed in prior years, in addition to \$111.3 million already programmed in 2018, to be obligated in FFY 2018. This is well beyond the obligation goal set for 2018, and would help to spend down past years' unobligated balance.

Overall, the semi-annual status updates received in October 2017 indicated that reasons for the low obligation rate in FFY 2017 can be attributed largely to right of way acquisition causing project delays. Internal and external coordination continue to challenge the project implementation process with sponsors reporting difficulty specifically in navigating state and federal requirements, such as GATA and Buy America. Different from past status update cycles, 2017 also showed a large portion of construction phases unobligated and delayed due to phase II engineering. The semi-annual status updates continue to improve staff understanding of project implementation and help raise sponsor awareness of project milestones, assisting sponsors in keeping projects moving forward towards accomplishment. The status updates from the last few years have helped to identify a pattern of common reasons for delay and will be considered when shaping future programming policies aimed at reducing delay further.

Five projects (4 CMAQ and 1 TAP-L) submitted cost and schedule change requests for committee consideration. The sponsors' requests are attached; a re-ranking analysis is available upon request.

A summary of the impacts of the staff recommended schedule and cost changes on the fiscal constraint of the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is shown below. The FFY 2018 Current Program amount included below is the new funding in FFY 2018 and carryover from former years. Approximately \$54 million is currently in Advanced Construction status in prior fiscal years and is accounted for in the FFY 2018 Unprogrammed Balance below, although staff does not expect the full amount of Advanced Construction funding to converted within the current federal fiscal year.

For Committee Consideration (CMAQ):

Des Plaines - Ballard Road from Bender Road to Good Avenue (TIP ID 03-12-0005)

The project was approved for \$20,000 federal (\$25,000 total) for phase 1 engineering in FFY 2012, \$36,000 federal (\$46,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2013 and \$453,000 federal (\$567,000 total) for construction in FFY 2013. Construction funds are currently deferred.

The sponsor is requesting reinstatement of construction funds and a cost change to fund construction engineering locally. The project has demonstrated readiness and is on the April 2018 state letting.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the reinstatement of construction funds and a cost change for Des Plaines – Ballard Road from Bender Road to Good Avenue (TIP ID 03-12-0005).

Bensenville – IL 83 from Bryn Mawr Ave to Foster Ave (TIP ID 08-16-0001)

The project was approved for \$32,000 federal (\$40,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2018 and \$267,000 federal (\$334,000 total) for construction in FFY 2019.

At the time of application, ROW acquisition was unanticipated. Ongoing phase I engineering determined the need for temporary easements along the proposed path. Construction costs increased since the application period due to anticipated additional drainage improvements. The Village would like to initiate a locally funded Phase II engineering agreement to get a kick-start on the design to allow ample time for the anticipated temporary easements. The sponsor is requesting to transfer \$32,000 federal (\$40,000 total) from phase 2 engineering to construction to offset increased construction costs.

A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking remained unchanged at 2nd among all 2016-2020 Bicycle Facility projects. Six funded projects rank lower than 2nd.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the transfer of \$32,000 federal (\$40,000 total) from phase 2 engineering in FFY 2018 to construction in FFY 2019 for Bensenville – IL 83 from Bryn Mawr Ave to Foster Ave (TIP ID 08-16-0001).

Bensenville – Railroad Avenue/Metra Station Access Improvements (TIP ID 08-17-0026)

The project was approved for \$400,000 federal (\$500,000 total) for construction in FFY 2022.

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to move \$400,000 federal (\$500,000 total) for construction from FFY 2022 to FFY 2018. The project is on the April 2018 state letting.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the schedule change to move \$400,000 federal (\$500,000 total) for construction from FFY 2022 to FFY 2018 for Bensenville – Railroad Avenue/Metra Station Access Improvements (TIP ID 08-17-0026).

Lake County – Washington Street at CN/Metra Crossing (TIP ID 10-08-0031)

The project was approved for \$16,939,000 federal (\$23,719,500 total) for construction in FFY 2013. The project was let for bid in FFY 2014 and is almost fully constructed.

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$2,098,900 federal (\$2,623,600 total) for construction. \$1.25M of the increased project cost for construction is directly related to the CN/Wisconsin Central Railroad requests for additional work, impacts and delays by the railroad and flagging costs. The remaining balance of the requested cost increase for construction is related to project delays and additional necessary work related to items such as soils, structural work, traffic control, traffic signals and utilities. An increase in construction engineering is requested as original project completion of construction phase was anticipated to be in November 2016 and due to construction delays, completion is anticipated for late 2017.

A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking remained unchanged at 3rd among all 2012-2016 Bottleneck Elimination projects. Zero funded projects rank lower than 3rd.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the cost increase of \$2,098,900 federal (\$2,623,600 total) for construction for Lake County – Washington Street at CN/Metra Crossing (TIP ID 10-08-0031).

For Committee Consideration (TAP-L):

Hanover Park – Hawk Hollow Forest Preserve Trail (TIP ID 08-16-0003)

The project was approved for \$19,000 federal (\$23,700 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2016 and \$72,800 federal (\$91,000 total) for construction in FFY 2017.

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$30,900 federal (\$38,600 total) for construction in FFY 2018 due to an altered alignment and higher than anticipated construction engineering costs. The project is on the April 2018 state letting.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the cost increase of \$30,900 federal (\$38,600 total) for construction in FFY 2018 for Hanover Park – Hawk Hollow Forest Preserve Trail (TIP ID 08-16-0003).

The City is submitting to have funding reinstated for the Construction and Construction Engineering of the regionally important Ballard Road Sidepath Project. The project is on track for the April 27, 2018 IDOT letting.

At the September 3, 2015 CMAP CMAQ Project Selection Committee, the City of Des Plaines submitted a Cost Change Request form to consolidate surplus ENG1, ENG2, ROW and CE funds to the CONST phase in preparation for a November 2015 letting of the Ballard Road Sidepath Project. The final plans and specifications were complete and approved through IDOT. The only remaining piece was closing on a small strip of right-of-way needed along Ballard Road in order to construct the project. Unfortunately negotiations fell through and so the project had to be pulled from the November 2015 letting.

After further attempts at negotiation were unsuccessful and hit a dead-end, the City was forced to backtrack, working with IDOT on an agreement for the use of Quick-Take condemnation. The right-of-way acquisition was restarted using City funds with appraisals conducted in IDOT's name. On November 21, 2017, a judge issued a Preliminary Just Compensation decision for the required strip of right-of-way. The City has submitted the funds for the right-of-way. And contracted with the design consultant for the updating and resubmittal of the plans to IDOT for the April 2018 letting.

With all of the project elements in place, the City is requesting reinstatement of grant funds to allow the project to proceed to construction.

Additional Comments

The Ballard Road Sidepath project closes a critical and currently dangerous gap in the Northwest Municipal Conference planned 36-mile Evanston-Elgin Regional Bikeway. When combined with four other programmed or completed projects, the sidepath will provide a continuous safe bicycle and pedestrian corridor through the length of Des Plaines. As well as providing a connection to the 58-mile long regional Des Plaines River Trail.

In addition to the regional importance, the sidepath project will provide a safe pedestrian connection between residential areas on the east side of the I-294 Tollway and North School and Downtown Des Plaines to the west. Once completed it will represent the only formal pedestrian/bicycle access across the I-294 Tollway for miles in either direction.

The project involves the replacement of a grass path with a limestone path in the Forest Preserve District of DuPage County. The path was to be at-grade and match the limits in the existing condition. Included in the scope was Phase I, II, and III engineering. The Forest Preserve District of DuPage County recently built a bridge crossing County Farm Road and extended their existing limestone path. As a result of this improvement the topography has changed and the alignment has been altered.
